13 TO ESTABLISH A COMMITTEE TO BE KNOWN AS THE "PARDONS AND  
14 CLEMENCY REFORM COMMITTEE.

17 NOW THEREFORE,

18 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-NINTH GENERAL  
19 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

21 SECTION 1. (a) There is established the Pardons and Clemency Reform  
22 Committee to be composed of twelve (12) members. Four (4) members shall be  
23 appointed by the Governor, four (4) members shall be appointed by the Speaker  
24 of the House, and four (4) members shall be appointed by the President Pro  
25 Tempore of the Senate. One (1) person appointed by the Governor shall be a  
26 representative of a Crime Victims Organization in this state. One (1) member  
27 appointed by the Governor shall be a member of the Board of Parole and  
28 Community Rehabilitation.

29 (b) The members of the committee shall select a chairman.

30 (c) The members of the committee shall serve without compensation.

31

32 SECTION 2. The committee shall examine the process of review and  
33 approval of pardons and clemency in this state and shall make recommendations  
34 to the Arkansas General Assembly and the Governor for measures to improve the  
35 system of pardons and clemency. The committee shall make its recommendations

1 not later than two (2) weeks before the sine die adjournment of the Seventy-  
2 Ninth General Assembly.
