11 REQUESTING THAT ALL CHANCERY JUDGES STRICTLY ENFORCE ALL
12 LAWS REGARDING THE PAYMENT OF CHILD SUPPORT.

14 WHEREAS, every child has a legal right to be supported by both
15 parents; and

17 WHEREAS, the Arkansas General Assembly has stated the "public policy" of
18 the State of Arkansas unequivocally regarding the legal obligation non-
19 custodial parents have regarding the payment of child support; and

21 WHEREAS, the Arkansas General Assembly has committed substantial
22 resources to the funding, equipping, and staffing of child support offices
23 state-wide to facilitate the collection of child support and to carry out the
24 stated "public policy"; and

26 WHEREAS, the custodial parents and those dedicated to assist them in the
27 collection of child support are dependent upon the Chancery Judges of this
28 state to bring the law to bear upon those non-custodial parents who seek to
29 elude this important legal obligation.

31 NOW THEREFORE,

32 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-NINTH GENERAL
33 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

1 THAT the Seventy-Ninth General Assembly of the State of Arkansas
2 respectfully requests that all Chancery Judges effectuate the stated "public
3 policy", expedite cases and hearings involving the collection of child
4 support, and strictly enforce all laws regarding the payment of child support.
