8 *PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION TO REMOVE*
9 *THE PROVISION THAT THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE OFFICE OF*
10 *GOVERNOR DEVOLVE UPON THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR DURING THE*
11 *GOVERNOR_S ABSENCE FROM THE STATE AND, LIKEWISE, UPON THE*
12 *PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE DURING THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR_S*
13 *ABSENCE FROM THE STATE OR UPON THE SPEAKER OF THE ASSEMBLY*
14 *DURING THE ABSENCE OF THE GOVERNOR, THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR, AND*
15 *THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE*

18 *TO REMOVE THE PROVISION THAT UPON THE GOVERNOR_S ABSENCE FROM*
19 *THE STATE THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR BECOMES ACTING GOVERNOR*

23 *BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY,*
24 *OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE SENATE, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH*
25 *HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:*

27 *That the following is hereby proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of the state of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the*
28 *electors of the state for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting*
29 *thereon at such election, adopt such amendment, the same shall become a part of the Constitution of the state of Arkansas, to wit:*

31 *"SECTION 1. Sections 4 and 5 of Amendment 6 to the Constitution of Arkansas are hereby amended to read as follows:*

32 *Section 4. In case of the impeachment of the Governor, or his removal from office, death, inability to discharge the powers and*
33 *duties of the said office, or resignation, the powers and duties of the office, shall devolve upon the Lieutenant Governor for the residue of the*
34 *term or until the disability shall cease. But when the Governor shall, with the consent of the legislature, be out of the State, in time of war, at*
35 *the head of a military force thereof, he shall continue commander-in-chief of all the military force of the State.*

1 Section 5. The Lieutenant Governor shall possess the same qualifications of eligibility for the office as the Governor. He shall be
2 President of the Senate, but shall have only a casting vote therein in case of a tie vote. If during a vacancy of the office of Governor, the
3 Lieutenant Governor shall be impeached, displaced, resign, die, or become incapable of performing the duties of his office, the President of the
4 Senate shall act as Governor until the vacancy be filled or the disability shall cease; and if the President of the Senate for any of the above
5 causes shall become incapable of performing the duties pertaining to the office of Governor, the Speaker of the Assembly shall act as Governor
6 until the vacancy be filled or the disability shall cease. "
