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## **HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION**

7 FOR A PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO PROHIBIT AD

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### **Subtitle**

11 FOR A PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO PROHIBIT AD  
12 VALOREM TAXES ON CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY.

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14 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-NINTH GENERAL  
15 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE SENATE, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS  
16 ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

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18 That the following is hereby proposed as an amendment to the Constitution  
19 of the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the  
20 state for approval or rejection at the next general election for  
21 Representatives and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at  
22 such election, adopt such amendment, the same shall become a part of the  
23 Constitution of the State of Arkansas, to wit:

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25 SECTION 1. No ad valorem tax shall be levied upon passenger vehicles,  
26 including automobiles, light trucks and vans with a three-fourths (3/4) ton or  
27 less manufacturer's rated capacity, by the State or any of its political  
28 subdivisions.

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30 SECTION 2. All provisions in the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
31 or any amendment thereto, or in the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and  
32 amendments thereto, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

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34 SECTION 3. This amendment shall become effective on January 1, 1995.
