9 IN RECOGNITION OF FORMER JUSTICE THURGOOD MARSHALL.

11 WHEREAS, former Justice Thurgood Marshall passed from this life on
12 Sunday, January 23, 1993, at the age of 84; and

13 WHEREAS, Justice Marshall had 24 years of distinguished service on the
14 United States Supreme Court; and

15 WHEREAS, Justice Marshall had the distinction of being the first black
16 American to serve on the Supreme Court; and

17 WHEREAS, Justice Marshall is known as one of the heros of the civil
18 rights movement, both during the time of his service as a Justice and during
19 his years as a civil rights attorney; and

20 WHEREAS, Justice Marshall served for more than 20 years as the Director-
21 Counsel of the NAACP Legal Defense in Education Fund, Inc.; and

22 WHEREAS, Justice Marshall_s greatest legal victory came in 1954 with the
23 Supreme Court Decision in Brown v. Board of Education, which ended the
24 "separate but equal" system of racial segregation in public schools.

26 NOW THEREFORE,

27 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-NINTH GENERAL
28 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

30 That this Resolution is adopted in respectful memory of former Justice
31 Thurgood Marshall and in the recognition for his many valuable contributions
32 to this country.
