16 WHEREAS, the Rollin_ Razorbacks and Coach Harry Vines, based in
17 Sherwood, Arkansas, and sponsored by the Sherwood Chamber of Commerce, are an
18 internationally-known basketball team; and

20 WHEREAS, the Rollin_ Razorbacks and Coach Harry Vines captured their
21 first national championship in 1991 when the National Wheelchair Basketball
22 Association Final Four was held in Little Rock; and

24 WHEREAS, four of the Rollin_ Razorbacks starters won gold medals playing
25 for the United States last summer in the Paralympics held in Barcelona, Spain;

28 WHEREAS, the Rollin_ Razorbacks and Coach Harry Vines ended the 1992-93
29 basketball season with a 27-3 record and the Number One spot in the National
30 Wheelchair Basketball Association poll; and

32 WHEREAS, the Rollin_ Razorbacks and Coach Harry Vines won their second
33 national championship in four years by knocking off Casa Colina, California,
34 in the National Wheelchair Basketball Association Championship Game held on

1 March 27, 1993, in Boston, Massachusetts.
