16 REQUESTING THE GOVERNOR, ALL CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICERS, THE
17 HOUSE, THE SENATE, LEGISLATIVE AUDIT AND LEGISLATIVE
18 COUNCIL TO RECYCLE PAPER.

20 WHEREAS, the Governor, all constitutional officers, the House of
21 Representatives, the Senate, Legislative Audit and Legislative Council use
22 tremendous volumes of paper;

23

24 WHEREAS, Arkansas Code § 8-9-101, which was enacted in 1991, provides
25 that "it is the policy of the State of Arkansas to encourage and promote
recycling";

26

27 WHEREAS, Arkansas Code § 8-9-203, which was also enacted in 1991,
28 requires all governmental entities to recycle those recyclable products
29 generated as a result of the entity's operations;

30

31 WHEREAS, the General Assembly has a responsibility to conduct its
32 business in accordance with the established policies of the state;

33

34 WHEREAS, the Secretary of State is responsible for maintenance of the
35 State Capitol grounds; and

2 WHEREAS, the Governor, all constitutional officers, and the General
3 Assembly should strive to set an environmental example that encourages other
4 agencies of state and local government as well as private enterprise to
5 recycle,

7 NOW THEREFORE,

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-NINTH GENERAL
9 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

11 That the Governor, all constitutional officers, the House of
12 Representatives, the Senate, Legislative Audit and Legislative Council are
13 requested to recycle paper and the Secretary of State is requested to assist
14 in recycling efforts.
