7 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 12-12-211 TO ADD AN
9 ADDITIONAL SUBSECTION TO PROVIDE APPROPRIATE RESTRICTIONS
10 ON ACCESS TO RECORDS FROM THE ARKANSAS CRIME INFORMATION
11 CENTER; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 **Subtitle**

14 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE APPROPRIATE RESTRICTIONS ON ACCESS TO
15 RECORDS FROM THE ARKANSAS CRIME INFORMATION CENTER."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 12-12-211 is amended to add a new subsection
20 to read as follows:

21 "(e) *An elected law enforcement officer of a political subdivision of
this state shall not be allowed access to information from the Arkansas Crime
Information Center unless either the elected law enforcement officer or a law
enforcement officer within his department has successfully completed the
preparatory program of police training required by the Arkansas Commission on
Law Enforcement Standards and Training for certification of law enforcement
officers.*"

29 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
30 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
31 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

32

33 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
34 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
35 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without

1 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
2 act are declared to be severable.

3

4 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
5 hereby repealed.
