## 7 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 7-5-304 TO PROVIDE THAT THE  
9 ELECTION POLLING PLACES SHALL REMAIN OPEN UNTIL 10:00 P.M.  
10 ON THE DATE OF THE GENERAL ELECTION FOR PRESIDENT OF THE  
11 UNITED STATES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## 13 **Subtitle**

14 "*TO PROVIDE FOR ELECTION POLLING PLACES TO REMAIN OPEN UNTIL 10:00*  
15 *P.M. ON DATE OF GENERAL ELECTION FOR PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED*  
16 *STATES.*"

18 *BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:*

20 *SECTION 1.* Arkansas Code 7-5-304 is amended to read as follows:

21 "*7-5-304. Opening and closing polls - Time.*

22 *The polls shall be opened at 8:00 a.m., and shall remain open continuously until 7:30 p.m. provided that the county board of*  
23 *election commissioners or, in a primary election, the county committee may open the polls prior to 8:00 a.m. but in no instance earlier than 7:00*  
24 *a.m. Furthermore the polls shall remain continuously open until 10:00 p.m. at general elections for the President of the United States, if by*  
25 *November 30, 1995, five (5) states in the Eastern, Central or Mountain time zones have passed or adopted statutes or regulations that require*  
26 *a 10:00 p.m. Central Standard Time closing. The Secretary of State shall determine if such statutes or regulations have been passed or*  
27 *adopted and notify each county board of election commissioners that polls shall remain continuously open until 10:00 p.m. "*

29 *SECTION 2.* All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987  
30 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

32 *SECTION 3.* If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity  
33 shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end  
34 the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

1           *SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.*
