7 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE PHYSICIANS TO REPORT PATIENTS WHO
9 POSE A SERIOUS RISK TO THEMSELVES OR OTHERS IF ALLOWED TO
10 OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

12 **Subtitle**

13 "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE PHYSICIANS TO REPORT PATIENTS WHO
14 POSE A SERIOUS RISK TO THEMSELVES OR OTHERS IF ALLOWED TO
15 OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18

19 SECTION 1. Any physician who believes a patient_s medical condition
20 impairs the patient_s ability to operate a motor vehicle to such an extent
21 that the patient would pose serious risk to themselves or others if permitted
22 to drive a motor vehicle, may report the information to the Office of Driver
23 Services of the Department of Finance and Administration. Upon receiving a
24 report the Department shall conduct a hearing on the issue of whether the
25 patient_s license to operate a motor vehicle should be revoked.

26

27 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
28 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
29 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

30

31 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
32 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
33 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
34 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
35 act are declared to be severable.

2 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
3 hereby repealed.
