# A Bill

SENATE BILL

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 27-72-310 TO PROVIDE THAT  
9 THE STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION SHALL NOT DISAPPROVE ANY  
10 STATE AID ROAD BRIDGE CONTRACT MERELY BECAUSE A RAILROAD  
11 TANK CAR IS USED IN THE CONSTRUCTION; AND FOR OTHER  
12 PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

14 "TO PROVIDE THAT RAILROAD TANK CARS MAY BE USED IN STATE  
16 ROAD BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION."

17  
18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19  
20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-72-310(a) is amended to read as follows:

21 "(a) All proposals covering work to be performed on state aid roads in  
22 each county in this state shall be under contract let and approved by the  
23 State Highway Commission, upon request from the county judge of the county and  
24 in accordance with the procedures prescribed in §27-67-206, as amended, and  
25 other laws of this state pertaining to contracts for the construction of state  
26 highways, which laws shall be equally applicable to all contracts let by the  
27 State Highway Commission for the construction of state aid roads under this  
28 subchapter. The State Highway Commission shall not disapprove any contract  
29 merely because railroad tank cars are proposed to be used in the construction  
30 or repair of any bridge which is the subject of the contract."

31

32 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
33 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
34 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

1           SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
2 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
3 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
4 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
5 act are declared to be severable.

7           SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
8 hereby repealed.
