7 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 9-12-315 TO PROVIDE THAT
9 THE COURT IS NOT REQUIRED TO DIVIDE MARITAL PROPERTY AT
10 THE TIME OF DIVORCE IF EITHER PARTY IS INVOLVED IN
11 BANKRUPTCY PROCEEDINGS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 **Subtitle**

14 "PROVIDE THAT THE COURT IS NOT REQUIRED TO DIVIDE MARITAL
15 PROPERTY AT TIME OF DIVORCE IF EITHER PARTY IS INVOLVED IN
16 BANKRUPTCY PROCEEDINGS."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 9-12-315 is amended by inserting an additional
21 subsection at the end thereof to read as follows:

22 "(c) The court is not required to address the division of property at
23 the time a divorce decree is entered if either party is involved in a
24 bankruptcy proceeding."

25

26 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
27 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
28 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

29

30 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
31 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
32 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
33 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
34 act are declared to be severable.

1 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
2 hereby repealed.
