**SENATE BILL    595**

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## 7   **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8       "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE TITLE 6, CHAPTER 63,  
9           SUBCHAPTER 3, THE HIGHER EDUCATION EXPENDITURE RESTRICTION  
10          ACT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## 12           **Subtitle**

13       "AN ACT TO AMEND THE HIGHER EDUCATION EXPENDITURE  
14           RESTRICTION ACT."

15

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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18       SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 6-63-304 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
19           "6-63-304. Payroll Deductions and Promotional Items. (a) The governing  
20 board for each institution of higher education may permit deductions from the  
21 payrolls of the institution's employees for contributions to the various  
22 institutional fundraising, foundations, and capital campaigns of the  
23 institutions and its entities when authorized by such employees. Provided  
24 further, the contributions shall be strictly voluntary and in no instance  
25 shall the institution coerce or intimidate their employees to make such  
26 contributions.

27           (b) *The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall establish for each  
28 requesting postsecondary educational institution a special appropriation line  
29 item to be used in the acquisition of promotional items. When an institution  
30 wishes to transfer monies from its operating expenses appropriation to the  
31 promotional items line, the Board of Trustees shall approve the request and  
32 forward it to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State for processing.*"

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34       SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 6-63-305(b) is hereby amended to read as  
35 follows:

1        "(b) The following maximum number of new additional positions is  
 2 established for the biennium for the following institutions of higher  
 3 education, at salary rates not to exceed the salary rate of comparable  
 4 positions established in the regular salaries section of the biennial  
 5 appropriations act for operations for each institution:

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9         SECTION 3. *SPECIAL ALLOWANCES.* For the purpose of providing necessary  
10 allowances for housing and other unusual expenses incurred by or on behalf of  
11 the athletic directors, associate and assistant athletic directors, head  
12 coaches and assistant coaches in the men's and women's Athletic Departments at  
13 the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, the Board of Trustees may make  
14 special allowances available therefor in such amounts as the Board of Trustees  
15 may determine as justified, an equitable allowance in view of the unusual and  
16 exacting duties of said athletic directors, associate and assistant athletic  
17 directors, head coaches and assistant coaches, and for the purpose of  
18 providing such allowances, the Board of Trustees is authorized to expend from  
19 the auxiliary income of the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, which is  
20 derived from athletic event receipts, or from contributions from sources other  
21 than state funds, an amount not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) each  
22 for such purposes during each year of the 1993-95 biennium for the athletic  
23 directors, associate athletic directors, and head coaches, and an amount not  
24 to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000) each for the assistant athletic  
25 directors and assistant coaches. Any such allowances shall be in addition to  
26 the regular salary of such athletic directors, associate and assistant  
27 athletic directors, head coaches and assistant coaches. Further, the  
28 University of Arkansas, Fayetteville shall report annually to the Arkansas  
29 Legislative Joint Auditing Committee the exact disposition of the special  
30 allowance funds authorized herein.

31         In recognition of the extra work involved in the participation of  
32 intercollegiate athletic teams in post-season competition, and to promote  
33 exceptional achievement in the total sports program, the Chancellor of the  
34 University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, in accordance with policies issued by  
35 the Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas, may approve additional

1 compensation of up to one month's salary for the Athletic Department and Band  
2 personnel when any athletic team participates in post-season competition or  
3 achieves exceptional recognition, which shall be in addition to the regular  
4 salaries authorized by law, provided that the additional compensation shall be  
5 paid from contributions from sources other than public funds.

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7         SECTION 4. SPECIAL ALLOWANCES. For the purpose of providing necessary  
8 allowances for housing and other unusual expenses incurred by or in behalf of  
9 the athletic director, assistant athletic director, head basketball coach, and  
10 assistant coaches at the University of Arkansas at Little Rock, the Board of  
11 Trustees may make special allowances available therefor in such amounts as the  
12 Board of Trustees may determine as justified, an equitable allowance in view  
13 of the unusual and exacting duties of said athletic director, assistant  
14 athletic director, head basketball coach, and assistant coaches, and for the  
15 purpose of providing such allowances, the Board of Trustees is authorized to  
16 expend from the auxiliary income of the University of Arkansas at Little Rock,  
17 which is derived from athletic event receipts, an amount not to exceed twenty  
18 thousand dollars (\$20,000) in the aggregate for such purposes during each year  
19 of the 1993-95 biennium for the athletic director and head basketball coach,  
20 and ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) in the aggregate for such purposes during  
21 the 1993-95 biennium for the assistant athletic director and assistant  
22 coaches. Provided that any such allowances shall be in addition to the regular  
23 salary of such athletic director, assistant athletic director, head basketball  
24 coach and assistant coaches, as established herein provided that the amount of  
25 such allowance shall not exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) per annum for  
26 any one salaried position. Further, the University of Arkansas at Little Rock  
27 shall report annually to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee the exact  
28 disposition of the special allowance funds authorized herein.

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30         SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
31 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
32 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
33 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
34 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
35 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

1 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
2 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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4 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
5 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
6 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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8 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
9 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
10 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
11 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
12 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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14 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
15 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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17 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
18 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that changes in various accounting and  
19 expenditure provisions of the State are necessary in order to promote  
20 efficiency; and that the provisions of this Act provide such changes.  
21 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
22 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
23 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.
