# A Bill

**SENATE BILL**

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## For An Act To Be Entitled

7 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED §§ 17-24-201, 17-  
8 24-301 AND 17-24-302(a) TO DELETE THE UNITED STATES  
9 CITIZENSHIP REQUIREMENT FOR MEMBERS OF THE ARKANSAS BOARD  
10 OF EXAMINERS IN COUNSELING; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

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## Subtitle

13 "TO DELETE THE U.S. CITIZENSHIP REQUIREMENT FOR MEMBERS OF  
14 THE ARKANSAS BOARD OF EXAMINERS IN COUNSELING."

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17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-24-201(b) is hereby amended to read as  
20 follows:

21 "(b) Appointments shall ensure that the board consists of residents of  
22 Arkansas, at least one (1) member of each sex, and at least one (1) member of  
23 an ethnic minority."

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25 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 17-24-301 is hereby amended to read as  
26 follows:

27 "17-24-301. Licensed professional counselor - Qualifications.

28 The board shall issue a license as a licensed professional counselor to  
29 each applicant who files an application upon a form and in such a manner as  
30 the board prescribes, accompanied by a fee as set by the board, and who  
31 furnishes satisfactory evidence of the following to the board that:

32 (1) The applicant is not a minor under the laws of Arkansas;

33 (2) The applicant is highly regarded in personal character and  
34 professional ethics;

35 (3) The applicant is a resident of or is in the act of establishing

1 residency in the State of Arkansas;

2       (4) The applicant is not in violation of any of the provisions of this  
3 chapter and the rules and regulations adopted hereunder;

4       (5) The applicant has received a graduate degree from a regionally  
5 accredited institution of higher education which is primarily professional  
6 counseling in content and has accumulated at least thirty-six (36) graduate  
7 semester hours and which meets the academic and training content standard  
8 established by the board. The board shall use the standards for the  
9 preparation of counselors prepared by that special professional association  
10 nationally as a guide in establishing the standards for counseling;

11       (6) The applicant has three (3) years of supervised full-time  
12 experience in professional counseling acceptable to the board. One (1) year of  
13 experience may be gained for each thirty (30) graduate semester hours earned  
14 beyond the master's degree, provided that the hours are clearly related to the  
15 field of counseling and are acceptable to the board. In no case may the  
16 applicant have less than one (1) year of professional experience; and

17       (7) The applicant will declare special competencies and demonstrate  
18 professional competence in specialty areas by passing a written or oral or  
19 situational examination, or any combination thereof, as the board will  
20 prescribe. Upon examination of credentials the board, by a majority of the  
21 board members present and voting, may consider such credentials adequate  
22 evidence of professional competence and recommend to the chairman of the board  
23 that a license be approved in that specialty."

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25       SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 17-24-302(a) is hereby amended to read as  
26 follows:

27       "(a) The board shall issue a license of licensed associate counselor to  
28 each applicant who meets the requirements established in § 17-24-301, with the  
29 exception of subdivision (6) of that section."

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31       SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
32 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
33 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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35       SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to

1 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
2 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
3 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
4 act are declared to be severable.

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6 SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
7 hereby repealed.

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
