# A Bill

**SENATE BILL 610**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR ADDITIONAL EXTRA HELP  
9 FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION - SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF  
10 WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS  
11 APPROPRIATED BY ACT 1108 OF 1991, FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE  
12 BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND FOR OTHER  
13 PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

16 "AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION - SCHOOL FOR THE  
17 DEAF SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the  
22 Department of Education - School for the Deaf, to be payable from the School  
23 for the Deaf Fund Account, for additional extra help of the Department of  
24 Education - School for the Deaf which shall be supplemental and in addition to  
25 those funds appropriated in Section 3 of Act 1108 of 1991, for the remainder  
26 of the biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the following:

32 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF - GENERAL REVENUE.  
33 *There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education - School for the*  
34 *Deaf, to be payable from the School for the Deaf Fund Account, for the*  
35 *Department of Education - School for the Deaf, the following:*

1           (A) Effective July 1, 1993, the balance of the appropriation provided  
 2 in Items (01) and (02) of Section 1 of Act 642 of 1993, for professional fees  
 3 and services and gymnasium pool renovation, in a sum not to exceed  
 4 ..... \$258,094.

5  
 6           SECTION 3. CARRY FORWARD. The unexpended balance of funds authorized  
 7 for Professional Fees and Services and Gymnasium Pool Renovation in Act 642 of  
 8 1993 on June 30, 1993, shall be carried forward and made available for the  
 9 same purpose during the biennial period ending June 30, 1995.

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11           SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
 12 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
 13 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
 14 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
 15 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 16 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control  
 17 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the  
 18 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
 19 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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21           SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
 22 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
 23 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
 24 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
 25 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
 26 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
 27 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
 28 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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30           SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
 31 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
 32 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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34           SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
 35 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such

1 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
2 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
3 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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5 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
6 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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8 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
9 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly meeting in Regular Session, that funds provided  
10 by the Seventy-Eighth General Assembly for the operations of the Department of  
11 Education - School for the Deaf are, due to unforeseen circumstances,  
12 insufficient for the Department of Education - School for the Deaf to continue  
13 to provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act  
14 will provide the necessary monies for the Department of Education - School for  
15 the Deaf to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of  
16 this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and  
17 provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is  
18 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate  
19 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and  
20 effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
