## 7 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPUTY PROSECUTOR FOR SCOTT  
9 COUNTY TO RESIDE OUTSIDE THE FIFTEENTH DISTRICT SO LONG AS  
10 HE MAINTAINS A REGULAR PRACTICE WITHIN SCOTT COUNTY; AND  
11 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## 13 **Subtitle**

14 "TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPUTY PROSECUTOR FOR SCOTT COUNTY TO  
15 RESIDE OUTSIDE THE FIFTEENTH DISTRICT."

16

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 16-21-2004(d) is amended to read as follows:  
20 "(d) All deputies shall reside in the Fifteenth Judicial District,  
21 provided however, the deputy prosecuting attorney for Scott County may reside  
22 outside the Fifteenth Judicial District so long as he maintains a regular  
23 practice of law within Scott County."

24

25 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
26 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
27 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

28

29 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
30 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
31 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
32 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
33 act are declared to be severable.

35 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are

1 hereby repealed.

4 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General  
5 Assembly that no attorney at law resides within Scott County who can legally  
6 serve as the deputy prosecuting attorney for the county; that this act  
7 authorizes a non-resident of Scott County to serve as the deputy prosecuting  
8 attorney for Scott County; and that this act should be given effect  
9 immediately in order to give the prosecuting attorney of the Fifteenth  
10 Judicial District the authority to provide services within the district as  
11 soon as possible. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and  
12 this act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,  
13 health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage  
14 and approval.
