SENATE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 12-10-310 TO REQUIRE
9 RECORDINGS OF 911 CALLS TO BE RETAINED FOR AT LEAST SIX
10 (6) MONTHS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

13 "TO REQUIRE RECORDINGS OF 911 CALLS TO BE RETAINED FOR AT
14 LEAST SIX (6) MONTHS."

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 12-10-310 is amended to read as follows:
19 "12-10-310. Records of calls.

20 (a) The 911 public safety communication center shall develop and
21 maintain a system for recording 911 calls received at the public safety
22 answering point (PSAP). A magnetic tape will satisfy this requirement.

23 (b) The records shall be retained for a period of at least six (6)
24 months from the date of the call and shall include the following information:

- 25 (1) Date and time the call was received;
26 (2) The nature of the problem;
27 (3) Action taken by the 911 public safety communication center
28 personnel."

30 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
31 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
32 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

34 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
35 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect

1 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
2 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
3 act are declared to be severable.

5 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
6 hereby repealed.
