SENATE BILL 687

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7 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO TRANSFER THE DIVISION OF ALCOHOL AND DRUG ABUSE
9 PREVENTION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO THE
10 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

12 **Subtitle**

13 "TRANSFER DIVISION OF ALCOHOL & DRUG ABUSE PREVENTION OF
14 DHS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH."

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16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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18 SECTION 1. The Division of Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention of the
19 Department of Human Services is transferred to the Department of Health
20 effective July 1, 1993, and shall thereafter be known as the "Bureau of
21 Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention".

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23 SECTION 2. All appropriations for the Division of Alcohol and Drug
24 Abuse Prevention for the 1993-95 biennium shall be deemed to be appropriated
25 to and shall be made available for the operation and maintenance of the Bureau
26 of Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention. The Director of the Department of
27 Finance and Administration shall transfer to the Department of Health all
28 appropriations and funds from any other sources in the custody or control of
29 the Department of Human Services which are designated for the Division of
30 Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention. All authorities and responsibilities
31 defined in Act 644 of 1977 as amended shall be administered by the Bureau of
32 Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention of the Department of Health.

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34 SECTION 3. Any and all statutory authority, rules and regulations,
35 powers, duties, functions, records, authorized positions, property, unexpended

1 balances of appropriations or authorizations, allocations or other funds,
2 transferred from the Division of Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention to the
3 Department of Human Services by Act 348 of 1985 are hereby transferred to the
4 Bureau of Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention of the Department of Health.

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6 SECTION 4. Any and all statutory authority, rules and regulations,
7 powers, duties, functions, records, authorized positions, property, unexpended
8 balances of appropriations or authorizations, allocations or other funds of
9 the *Division of Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention*, are hereby transferred to
10 the Bureau of Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention of the Department of Health.
11 The transfer shall include all employees, powers, duties, licenses,
12 privileges, equipment, vehicles, furniture, fixtures, supplies, books,
13 records, stock, goods, funds, unexpended appropriations and facilities of the
14 Division of Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention.

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16 SECTION 5. Other divisions in the Department of Human Services shall
17 determine by class, title, and grade the number of positions in such
18 divisions, if any, devoted to Division of Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention
19 functions according to the Department of Human Services Cost Allocation plan.
20 Such divisions shall make available for transfer to the Bureau of Alcohol and
21 Drug Abuse Prevention positions of the same class, title, and grade in numbers
22 not to exceed those identified by the Department of Human Services Cost
23 Allocation Plan. Such divisions shall also make available for transfer to the
24 Bureau of Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention the equipment and furnishings
25 presently associated with positions identified by the Department of Human
26 Services Cost Allocation Plan as full-time equivalents for Division of Alcohol
27 and Drug Abuse Prevention functions. The affected divisions of the Department
28 of Human Services shall enter into a memorandum of understanding to implement
29 these transfers.

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31 SECTION 6. All funds and appropriations set aside for the renovation of
32 the Benton Detoxification Center shall hereafter be transferred to the Bureau
33 of Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention of the Department of Health to be used
34 solely for the renovation of this center.

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1 SECTION 7. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
2 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
3 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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5 SECTION 8. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
6 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
7 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
8 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
9 act are declared to be severable.

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11 SECTION 9. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
12 hereby repealed.

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14 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the
15 General Assembly that the Division of Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention should
16 be transferred to the Department of Health; that the transfer should occur at
17 the beginning of the next fiscal year; and that such transfer will not occur
18 at the beginning of the next fiscal year unless this emergency clause is
19 adopted. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act
20 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
21 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.
