SENATE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
OPERATING EXPENSES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS, ITS
VARIOUS DIVISIONS AND THE ARKANSAS ARCHEOLOGICAL SURVEY
FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1995; AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

"AN ACT FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS APPROPRIATION."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
University of Arkansas, its various divisions and the Archeological Survey for
the 1993-95 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose
salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and
Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all
laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a
specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt
from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All
persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the
provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas
Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

4 SECTION 7. REFUND TO EXPENDITURES. Proceeds derived from the maturity
 5 or redemptions of investments as authorized in Section 6 of this Act for the
 6 University of Arkansas Soils Testing and Research Program shall be deemed
 7 "Refunds to Expenditures" for all monies invested.

8

9 SECTION 8. GRANTS AND CONTRACTS. The Arkansas Archeological Survey is
 10 authorized to enter into contracts with and to receive and expend gifts,
 11 grants, or other funds from federal, private, or other sources to be used in
 12 furtherance of the program of the Survey within the limitations of the maximum
 13 annual salary rates as set forth in this Act.

14

15 SECTION 9. USE AND DISBURSING OFFICER. The funds appropriated under
 16 Section 3 and allocated in Item (5) of Section 4 of this Act are to be used
 17 for the personal services and maintenance and general operation of the
 18 Arkansas Archeological Survey and for no other purpose. The Vice-President

27 SECTION 11. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
 28 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
 29 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
 30 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
 31 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

3 SECTION 12. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
4 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
5 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
6 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
7 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
8 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
9 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
10 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

11

12 SECTION 13. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
13 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and
14 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

15

16 SECTION 14. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
17 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
18 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
19 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
20 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

21

22 SECTION 15. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
23 with this Act are hereby repealed.

24

25 SECTION 16. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
26 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
27 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
28 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1993 is essential to the operation of
29 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
30 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
31 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1993 could work irreparable harm upon the
32 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
33 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
34 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
35 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.

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
