SENATE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT STATE BUILDING SERVICES SHALL HAVE
9 JURISDICTION OVER THE CAPITOL HILL BUILDING; AND FOR OTHER
10 PURPOSES."

Subtitle

13 "TO PROVIDE THAT STATE BUILDING SERVICES SHALL HAVE
14 JURISDICTION OVER THE CAPITOL HILL BUILDING."

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 SECTION 1. The maintenance, control, and operation of the Capitol Hill
19 Building is hereby transferred from the office of the Secretary of State to
20 the Arkansas State Building Services. Hereafter, the Capitol Hill Building
21 shall be used only as office space for state agencies. State Building
22 Services shall give first priority in allocating space to agencies which now
23 lease office space.

25 SECTION 2. On the effective date of this act, all funds, positions and
26 appropriations authorized for or available to the Office of the Secretary of
27 State for the maintenance, operation and improvements of the Capitol Hill
28 Building, as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, shall be
29 transferred to State Building Services, there to be used for the same purpose.

32 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
33 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
34 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

1 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
2 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
3 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
4 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
5 act are declared to be severable.

7 SECTION 54. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
8 hereby repealed.
