**SENATE BILL 732**

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## 7 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO EXEMPT GASOLINE OR DIESEL POWERED TRUCKS FROM  
9 THE RENTAL VEHICLE TAX; APPLY THE RESIDENTIAL MOVING TAX  
10 TO THE RENTAL OR LEASE OF GASOLINE OR DIESEL POWERED  
11 TRUCKS USED FOR COMMERCIAL OR RESIDENTIAL MOVING OR  
12 SHIPPING; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

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## 14 **Subtitle**

15 "*EXEMPT GASOLINE OR DIESEL POWERED TRUCKS FROM RENTAL VEHICLE*  
16 *TAX.*"

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18 *BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:*

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20 *SECTION 1.* Arkansas Code Annotated 526-52-311 is amended by adding a paragraph to read as follows:

21 "(i) The rental vehicle tax shall not apply to gasoline or diesel powered trucks rented or leased for residential moving or shipping."

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23 *SECTION 2.* Arkansas Code Annotated shall be amended to add 526-52-312 to read as follows:

24 "*526-52-312. Residential moving tax*

25 *(a) A commercial/residential moving tax at the rate of four and one-half percent (4-1/2%) shall apply to the short term rental of*  
26 *gasoline or diesel powered trucks rented or leased for residential moving or shipping. The four and one-half percent (4-1/2%) residential*  
27 *moving tax shall also apply to the sale of any tangible personal property sold in conjunction with the rental or lease of a gasoline or diesel*  
28 *powered truck rented or leased for residential moving or shipping.*

29 *(b) Except as provided otherwise in this section, the tax shall be collected, reported, and paid in the same manner and at the same*  
30 *time as is prescribed by law for the collection, reporting, and payment of the tax imposed by the Arkansas gross receipts tax, 526-52-101 et*  
31 *seq."*

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33 *SECTION 3.* All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987  
34 *Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.*

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1        *SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity*  
2    *shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end*  
3    *the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.*

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5        *SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.*

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7        *SECTION 6. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly that this act is necessary in order*  
8    *to eliminate confusion and simplify the collection of tax for the rental truck industry. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and*  
9    *this act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July*  
10   *1, 1993.*
