7 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 6, CHAPTER 13, SUBCHAPTER 6 OF THE
9 ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED BY ADDING A NEW SECTION
10 AUTHORIZING A SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS TO ENTER
11 INTO A WRITTEN AGREEMENT WITH A DISTRICT EMPLOYEE OR AN
12 ORGANIZATION REPRESENTING THE EMPLOYEE TO SUBMIT A
13 CONTROVERSY OVER A NEGOTIATION AGREEMENT OR PERSONNEL
14 POLICY TO BINDING ARBITRATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

16 **Subtitle**

17 "TO AUTHORIZE A SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS TO
18 ENTER INTO WRITTEN AGREEMENTS WITH EMPLOYEES TO SUBMIT
19 CONTROVERSIES TO BINDING ARBITRATION."

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22

23 SECTION 1. Title 6, Chapter 13, Subchapter 6 of the Arkansas Code is
24 hereby amended by adding a new section to read as follows:

25 "6-13-631. (a) The board of directors of a school district is hereby
26 authorized to enter into a written agreement with a district employee or an
27 organization representing a majority of the teachers of the district or an
28 organization representing a majority of the noncertified personnel of the
29 district to submit any existing controversy as to the meaning or application
30 of the specific terms of any negotiation agreement or personnel policy to
31 binding arbitration.

32 (b) Any arbitrator with the power to make binding decisions under the
33 written agreement in subsection (a) shall have no authority to add to,
34 subtract from, or modify any negotiation agreement or personnel policy of the
35 school district."

2 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
3 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
4 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

5

6 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
7 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
8 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
9 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
10 act are declared to be severable.

11

12 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
13 hereby repealed.
