       SECTION 8. REALLOCATION OF RESOURCES.
                                                Upon determination by the Board
26 of Correction and Community Punishment that a reallocation of resources within
27 the Department of Community Punishment and Department of Correction is

         SECTION 19. Notwithstanding any other provision of law or departmental

1 surplus and/or salvageable materials for the purpose of implementing 2 construction projects to benefit the Department and its various programs. 3 Before such projects may be undertaken, a Method of Finance must be submitted 4 for prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council, and review and approval 5 by the Department of Finance and Administration and the Arkansas State 6 Building Services. 7 SECTION 21. EXTRA SALARIES. There is hereby authorized, for the 9 Department of Correction, for the 1993-95 biennium, the following increases in 10 salaries for certain positions provided in the Regular Salary schedule in this 11 Act, and to be in addition to the annual amounts as established by the Uniform 12 Classification and Compensation Act, as amended, for three (3) full-time 13 physicians who are certified by the American Specialty Boards at rates of pay 14 not to exceed an additional \$4,500 per year. If certified in forensic 15 psychiatry, an additional \$2,500 per year will be allowed. Total extra 16 salaries may not exceed \$7,000 per year per position. In the event the 17 physician is not a full time employee, the amount specified herein shall be 18 adjusted proportionately to the amount of time worked for the Department of 19 Correction by that physician. 20 21 SECTION 22. It is hereby authorized that the Department of Correction 22 may move an incumbent classified as a Correctional Officer I, Grade 16, up to 23 Pay Level II of Grade 16, after the following criteria has been met: the 24 incumbent Correctional Officer I must have completed at least six (6) months 25 continuous service as a Correctional Officer I; and the incumbent must have 26 completed a minimum of two hundred (200) hours Correctional Officer training; 27 and the incumbent must have passed a six (6) months evaluation. 28 SECTION 23. MEDICAL SERVICES. If it has been found that the Department 29 30 cannot continue a medical contract with a private provider and the Board deems 31 it necessary to utilize Department staff to provide the required services, the 32 Department is allowed, upon notification of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the 33 State and after seeking prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council, to

34 utilize the contingent positions contained in Section 1 of this Act and make

35 the appropriate transfers from Professional Fees and Services character

1 contained in Section 3 of this Act to Regular Salaries, Personal Services 2 Matching and various Maintenance and General Operations classifications. SECTION 24. In the event the Department of Correction cannot accept 5 inmates from county jails due to insufficient bed space, the Department shall 6 reimburse the counties at a rate determined by the Board of Correction until 7 the appropriation provided for such purpose is exhausted. The prevailing rate 8 of the county jail will be considered by the Board in determining the rate to 9 be reimbursed. The appropriation provided by Item (08) of Section 3 may also 10 be used for contracts with county jails for pre-release inmates. 11 SECTION 25. In the event of a substantial increase in utility rates, 12 13 the Department of Correction is authorized to transfer any line item 14 appropriation in this Act to the Maintenance and Operation line item for 15 support of the increase after receiving approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer 16 of the State. 17 SECTION 26. TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATION WITHIN CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT 18 The Department of Correction is hereby authorized to transfer 20 appropriation between and/or among the various capital 21 improvements/construction projects authorized by the General Assembly. Such 22 transfers may be made only after approval by the Governor. Such authorization 23 shall in no way mean that the total amount of funds or appropriations for 24 capital improvement/construction projects be greater than that provided by the 25 General Assembly for the Department of Correction. 26 27 SECTION 27. MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES. In the event the Department 28 determines to enter into a professional contract for mental health services, 29 the Department may, upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and 30 after prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council, make appropriate 31 transfers from regular salaries, personal services matching and various 32 maintenance and operation classifications to the professional fees and 33 services classification for payment of the contractual amount. 34

SECTION 28. The Department of Correction is authorized to transfer

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1 funds from various Special Revenue and Cash Funds into the Inmate Care and 2 Custody Fund Account in order to adjust to the budget needs upon approval of 3 the Board of Correction and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. 5 SECTION 29. NEW FACILITIES. If it is found that contracting for the 6 operation of new facilities is economically beneficial to the State of 7 Arkansas, the Department of Correction may, after receiving approval of the 8 Chief Fiscal Officer, and seeking prior review by the Arkansas Legislative 9 Council, transfer from any line item appropriation contained in Section 3 of 10 this Act into the Professional Fees and Services character contained in 11 Section 3 of this Act to operate new facilities opened during the biennium. 12 SECTION 30. Receipts from cities or counties reimbursed to the 13 14 Department for daily care of city or county prisoners shall be accounted for 15 separately. The debt service of such receipts shall be used for payment of 16 debt service on bonds, loans or any other instruments used to finance regional 17 jail facilities. The operational portion of such receipts shall also be used 18 for debt service unless approval is received from the Director of the 19 Department of Finance and Administration for other usages. 20 SECTION 31. The Department of Correction is hereby authorized to 22 transfer appropriations between any line items authorized herein but only for 23 the purpose of financing construction or equipment for a facility of the 24 department. Any transfers authorized by this section shall require the 25 approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State after prior review by the 26 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. 27 28 SECTION 32. The Department of Correction may report to the Joint 29 Interim Committee on State Agencies and Governmental Affairs no later than 30 December 1 of each year regarding its efforts in rehabilitating the inmate 31 population. Such report may include the Department's rehabilitative efforts 32 regarding inmate education, specific job training, behavior modification, 33 psychological treatment and assistance, and substance abuse programs. 34 Further, the report is to include the amount of meritorious good time awarded 35 inmates by the Department for the successful completion of the various

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1 rehabilitative programs.
 2.
         SECTION 33. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
 4 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
 5 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
 6 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
 7 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 8 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
 9 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
10 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
11 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.
12
         SECTION 34. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
13
14 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
15 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
16 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
17 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
18 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
19 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
20 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
21

         SECTION 35. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
23 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the
24 Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

         SECTION 36. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
26
27 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
28 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
29 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
30 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.
31
         SECTION 37. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
32
33 with this Act are hereby repealed.
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SECTION 38. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the

1	Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
2	prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
3	the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1993 is essential to the operation of
4	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
5	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
6	date of this Act beyond July 1, 1993 could work irreparable harm upon the
7	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
8	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
9	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
10	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.
