17 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE SEVENTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
18 STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, A MAJORITY OF ALL
19 MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

21 That the following is hereby proposed as an amendment to the Constitution
22 of the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the
23 state for approval or rejection at the next general election for Senators and
24 Representatives, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at such
25 election, adopt such amendment, the same shall become a part of the
26 Constitution of the State of Arkansas, to wit:

28 SECTION 1. The provisions of Section 14 of Article 19 of this
29 constitution which prohibits lotteries shall not apply to the game of bingo
30 conducted by entities formed under the non-profit corporation laws of this
31 state. The General Assembly is hereby empowered to enact laws to implement
32 this amendment.

34 SECTION 2. This amendment shall become effective on January 1, 1995.
