## 7 **SENATE RESOLUTION**

8 URGING PRESIDENT CLINTON AND THE MEMBERS OF THE ARKANSAS  
9 CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION TO RECONSIDER THE PROPOSAL TO  
10 DRAMATICALLY INCREASE THE INLAND WATERWAYS FUEL TAX.

### 12 **Subtitle**

13 URGING PRESIDENT CLINTON AND ARKANSAS CONGRESSIONAL  
14 DELEGATION TO RECONSIDER PROPOSAL TO INCREASE THE INLAND  
15 WATERWAYS FUEL TAX.

17 WHEREAS, congressional and administration leaders are to be commended  
18 for exercising budgetary constraint, and for creating new ways for cutting  
19 expenditures while increasing general revenues as a means of reducing the  
20 federal deficit and our national debt; and

21 WHEREAS, the national objective of a vigorous economic recovery offering  
22 expanding employment opportunity without inflation can be accomplished only  
23 through the formation of new enterprise and the sound expansion of existing  
24 business and industry; and

25 WHEREAS, the American ideal and tradition is that of fair treatment for  
26 all, with an equitable distribution of both the benefits and costs of  
27 government in relation to actual need or the ability to pay; and

28 WHEREAS, it is currently proposed that the federal inland waterways fuel  
29 taxes be escalated dramatically from a current rate of 17 cents to \$1.29 per  
30 gallon by 1997 in order to increase federal revenues; and

31 WHEREAS, an increase of such magnitude would effectively eliminate use  
32 of the McClellan-Kerr Arkansas River Navigation System for transportation  
33 purposes, would devastate those industries which have invested billions of  
34 private dollars and created thousands of jobs in dependence upon low-cost  
35 water transportation; and

1        WHEREAS, the proposed increase in the inland waterway user fuel taxes  
2 would be detrimental to the economy of Arkansas and the United States,  
3 resulting in lost jobs, lost public and private investments, and higher prices  
4 for all,

6 NOW THEREFORE,

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE SEVENTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE  
8 STATE OF ARKANSAS:

10        The Arkansas Senate hereby respectfully urges and requests President  
11 Clinton to reconsider the proposal to dramatically increase federal inland  
12 waterways fuel taxes and urges the Arkansas Congressional Delegation to  
13 vigorously oppose such dramatic increase.

14        BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon adoption of this resolution the  
15 Secretary of the Senate shall transmit a copy hereof to President Clinton and  
16 to each member of the Arkansas Congressional Delegation.
