18 WHEREAS, Mr. Randolph Ford of Clarksville, Arkansas has served on the  
19 Arkansas Industrial Development Commission for ten years; and

21 WHEREAS, Mr. Ford is a general contractor with over forty-five years  
22 experience in commercial, institutional and retail construction; and

24 WHEREAS, Mr. Ford played a key role in locating Tyson\_s, Sara Lee, Wal-  
25 Mart, and Nite Lite in Johnson County, Arkansas; and

27 WHEREAS, Mr. Ford has played a major role in the evolution of the  
28 Arkansas Motion Picture Development Office and has been active in assisting  
29 the Office in recruiting the motion picture industry into this state; and

31 WHEREAS, Mr. Ford was responsible for constructing a new state-of-the-  
32 art water system which is the first of its kind in Arkansas and which is  
33 scheduled to be in operation in June, 1993; and

35 WHEREAS, Mr. Ford donated his time and expertise to serve as the general  
36 contractor on the expansion of the Clarksville Airport, which project was  
37 completed on time and within budget, primarily due to Mr. Ford\_s involvement
