## 7 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE AN ADDITIONAL POSITION FOR THE  
9 DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION - MATH AND SCIENCE SCHOOL WHICH  
10 SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE POSITIONS  
11 AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 3 OF ACT 1312 OF 1993 FOR THE  
12 REMAINDER OF THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1995; AND FOR  
13 OTHER PURPOSES."

## 15 **Subtitle**

16 "AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION  
17 - MATH & SCIENCE SCHOOL SUPPLEMENTAL  
18 POSITION."

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21

22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES . There is hereby established for the  
23 Department of Education - Math & Science School for the remainder of the  
24 fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the following maximum number of regular  
25 employees which shall be supplemental and in addition to those positions  
26 authorized in Section 3 of Act 1312 of 1993, whose salaries shall be governed  
27 by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas  
28 Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.  
29 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary  
30 is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said  
31 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
32 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
33 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
34 successor.

10         SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
11 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
12 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
13 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
14 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
15 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control  
16 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the  
17 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
18 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

19         SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
20 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
21 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
22 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
23 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
24 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
25 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
26 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

28         SECTION 4. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
29 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
30 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

31         SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
32 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
33 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
34 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this

1 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

2

3 SECTION 6. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
4 with this Act are hereby repealed.

5

6 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
7 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, meeting in Second Extraordinary Session, that  
8 the position of Dean of Students at the Arkansas School for Math & Science is  
9 necessary to effectively carry out the mission of the School; and that a delay  
10 in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper  
11 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an  
12 emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the  
13 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full  
14 force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
