24 pertaining to youth, assist in designing and implementing youth programs and
25 service projects, and aid in planning and carrying out Commission events; and

27 WHEREAS, the staff of the Martin Luther King, Jr. Commission and the
28 Junior King Commissioners played vital roles in the success of the National
29 Youth Assembly that brought more than 1,400 young people from around the
30 nation to Little Rock, Arkansas, on August 12th - 15th,

33 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SECOND EXTRAORDINARY
34 SESSION OF THE SEVENTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
