SENATE BILL 17

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES,
9 OPERATING EXPENSES, AND GRANTS FOR THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE
10 INSTITUTE AT THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS AT LITTLE ROCK FOR
11 THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1995; AND FOR OTHER
12 PURPOSES."

Subtitle

15 "AN ACT FOR THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE
16 INSTITUTE APPROPRIATION."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
21 Criminal Justice Institute at the University of Arkansas at Little Rock for
22 the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the following maximum number of regular
23 employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform
24 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its
25 successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any
26 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in
27 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
28 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
29 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
30 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

13 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Criminal
 14 Justice Institute at the University of Arkansas at Little Rock for the fiscal
 15 year ending June 30, 1995, the following maximum number of part-time or
 16 temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds
 17 appropriated herein for such purposes: five (5) temporary or part-time
 18 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the
 19 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for
 20 the appropriate classification.

21

22 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - GENERAL REVENUE. There is hereby
 23 appropriated, to the Criminal Justice Institute at the University of Arkansas
 24 at Little Rock, to be payable from the Department of Higher Education Grants
 25 Fund Account, for personal services, operating expenses, and grants of the
 26 Criminal Justice Institute at the University of Arkansas at Little Rock for
 27 the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the following:

8 SECTION 4. FUNDING TRANSFER. Upon appropriate documentation of need as

9 certified by the Director of the Department of Higher Education, and with the

10 approval of the Governor and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the State

11 Treasurer shall transfer such funds as may be necessary to the Department of

12 Higher Education Grants Fund Account from revenues accruing to the General

13 Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund to provide funding for the appropriation set

14 out herein.

15

16 SECTION 5. *The University of Arkansas at Little Rock Criminal Justice*

17 *Institute is hereby directed to develop an intern and/or staffing procedure*

18 *with the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff to ensure that minorities are*

19 *adequately represented in the development and staffing of this program. The*

20 *Institute shall submit to the Joint Budget Committee a yearly report*

21 *reflecting hiring and participation.*

22

23 SECTION 6. APPROPRIATIONS - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. *There is hereby*

24 *appropriated, to the Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training, to*

25 *be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund*

26 *accounts, the following:*

27

28 (A) *For constructing and equipping a Driver Training/Hazard Course at*

29 *the Law Enforcement Training Academy - East Camden, the sum of*

30 *.....\$500,000.*

31

32 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

33 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

34 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

35 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and

1 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
2 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
3 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
4 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
5 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

7 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
8 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
9 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
10 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
11 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
12 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
13 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
14 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

15

16 SECTION 9. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
17 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
18 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

19

20 SECTION 10. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
21 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
22 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
23 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
24 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

25

26 SECTION 11. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
27 with this Act are hereby repealed.

28

29 SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
30 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly meeting in Second Extraordinary Session, that
31 the passage of this Act is of critical importance in the provision of needed
32 resources to overcome severe public information and service deficiencies in
33 such areas as criminal justice instruction, crime intervention services, and
34 research activities. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and
35 this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,

1 health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage
2 and approval.
