SENATE BILL 18

For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR TIRE RECYCLING GRANTS
FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF POLLUTION CONTROL AND ECOLOGY WHICH
SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS
APPROPRIATED BY ACT 899 OF 1993, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
ENDING JUNE 30, 1995; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

"AN ACT TO MAKE A SUPPLEMENTAL
APPROPRIATION FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF
POLLUTION CONTROL AND ECOLOGY."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS - WASTE TIRE RECYCLING PROGRAM. There is
hereby appropriated, to the Department of Pollution Control and Ecology, to be
payable from the Waste Tire Grant Fund, for tire recycling grants of the
Department of Pollution Control and Ecology which shall be supplemental and in
addition to those funds appropriated in Section 24 of Act 899 of 1993, for the
fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the following:

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SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and

1 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
2 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
3 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
4 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
5 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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7 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
8 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
9 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
10 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
11 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
12 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
13 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
14 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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16 SECTION 4. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
17 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
18 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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20 SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
21 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
22 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
23 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
24 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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26 SECTION 6. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
27 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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29 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
30 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly meeting in Second Extraordinary Session, that
31 funds provided by the Seventy-Ninth General Assembly for the purpose of making
32 grants for tire recycling was insufficient for the Department of Pollution
33 Control and Ecology to continue to provide this essential governmental
34 service; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work
35 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential

1 governmental program. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and
2 this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,
3 health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of
4 its passage and approval.
