SENATE BILL 19

For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE EXTRA HELP FOR MID-SOUTH COMMUNITY
COLLEGE WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THE
AUTHORIZATION FOUND IN SECTION 2 OF ACT 696 OF 1993, FOR
THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1995; AND TO MAKE AN
APPROPRIATION TO THE SOUTHERN ARKANSAS UNIVERSITY-SAU-TECH
FOR CONSTRUCTING AND EQUIPPING FIRE TRAINING SATELLITE
FACILITIES LOCATED IN THE WASHINGTON/BENTON COUNTY AREA;
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

"AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE EXTRA HELP FOR MID-
SOUTH COMMUNITY COLLEGE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Mid-South
Community College, or its successor, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995,
the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known
as "Extra Help, payable from the Mid-South Technical College Fund or its
successor fund, which shall be supplemental and addition to those positions
authorized in Section 2 of Act 696 of 1993, the following: fifty (50)
temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed
those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its
successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the
Southern Arkansas University-SAU-Tech-Fire Training Academy, to be payable
from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, the

2 (A) For constructing and equipping Fire Training Satellite facilities
3 located in the Washington/Benton County area, the sum of \$150,000.

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5 SECTION 3. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Mid-
6 South Technical College, or its successor, for the 1993-95 biennium, the
7 following maximum number of regular employees which shall be supplemental and
8 in addition to those authorized in Item 24 of Section 1 of Act 696 of 1993
9 whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform
10 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its
11 successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any
12 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in
13 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
14 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
15 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
16 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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25 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
26 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
27 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
28 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
29 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
30 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
31 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
32 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
33 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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35 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

1 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
2 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
3 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
4 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
5 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
6 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
7 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

9 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
10 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
11 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

13 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
14 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
15 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
16 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
17 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

19 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
20 with this Act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Ninth General Assembly meeting in the Second Extraordinary Session, that Mid-South Community College is in need of additional staffing to address the various instructional programs of the institution and; without this authorization irreparable harm could be done to the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
