19 WHEREAS, Governor Jim Guy Tucker, recognizing the severity of the
20 juvenile crime problem, called the members of the General Assembly into
21 special session; and

22 WHEREAS, the members of the General Assembly share his concern and have
23 worked diligently to find solutions to this problem; and

24 WHEREAS, much progress has been made during this session but government
25 cannot solve the juvenile crime problem by itself; and

26 WHEREAS, the juvenile crime problem must also be addressed by concerned
27 community groups, neighborhoods, and ultimately the parents or guardians of
28 juveniles;
