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For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND THE ELECTRICIANS_ LICENSING LAW TO EXTEND
9 THE GRANDFATHER CLAUSE TO JUNE 30, 1996; AND FOR OTHER
10 PURPOSES."

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Subtitle

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17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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19 SECTION 1. Section 2 of Act 1076 of 1993, found in the Arkansas Code
20 as a note at the beginning of Subchapter 3, Chapter 25 of Title 17 is amended
21 to read as follows:

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"Applicants for a license pursuant to the provisions of this chapter
shall be exempt from the examination requirement of 17-25-203, provided the
applicant:

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(a) *has a current* license of the same class issued by an Arkansas
municipality prior to April 1, 1995;

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(b) has not had a municipal electrician's license or a state
electrician's license suspended or revoked for cause;

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(c) submits the appropriate fees; and

(d) applies for a license prior to June 30, 1996."

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SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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1 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
2 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
3 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
4 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
5 act are declared to be severable.

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7 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
8 hereby repealed.

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10 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the
11 General Assembly that Act 1076 of 1993 exempted from the examination
12 requirements of Arkansas Code 17-25-203 applicants for an electrician_s
13 license if the applicant had a license of the same class issued by an
14 Arkansas municipality prior to April 1, 1995; that the time frame of the
15 grandfather clause should be extended to January 1, 1996; that this act so
16 provides; and that this act should go into effect immediately in order to
17 avoid unnecessary burdens upon those persons who will come within the purview
18 of the grandfather clause. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to
19 exist and this act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the
20 public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and
21 after its passage and approval.
