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## 7 For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL TO KNOWINGLY RECORD  
9 INSTRUMENTS LACKING AUTHENTICITY AFFECTING THE TITLE TO  
10 REAL PROPERTY WITH THE INTENT OF ADVERSELY AFFECTING THE  
11 TITLE TO THE REAL PROPERTY; PROVIDING FOR TREBLE DAMAGES  
12 IN CIVIL ACTIONS TO CLEAR THE TITLE TO REAL PROPERTY  
13 ADVERSELY AFFECTED; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

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## 15 Subtitle

16 "TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL TO KNOWINGLY RECORD  
17 INSTRUMENTS LACKING AUTHENTICITY  
18 ADVERSELY AFFECTING TITLE AND PROVIDE  
19 DAMAGES IN CIVIL ACTIONS TO CLEAR THE  
20 TITLE ADVERSELY AFFECTED"

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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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24 SECTION 1. (a) It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to have  
25 placed of record in the office of the recorder of any county any instrument  
26 clouding or adversely affecting the title or interest of the true owner,  
27 lessee or assignee in real property or clouding or adversely affecting any  
28 bona fide interest in real property with the knowledge of the instrument \_  
29 lack of authenticity or genuineness and with the intent of clouding,  
30 adversely affecting, impairing or discrediting the title or other interest in  
31 the real property which may prevent the true owner, lessee or assignee from  
32 disposing of the real property, transferring or granting any interest in the  
33 real property or with the intent of procuring money or value from the true  
34 owner, lessee or assignee to clear the instrument from the records of the  
35 office of the recorder.

1           (b) Any person violating the provisions of subsection (a) of this  
2 section shall be guilty of a Class A misdemeanor.

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4           SECTION 2. Any owner, lessee or assignee of real property located in  
5 the State of Arkansas who suffers loss or damages as a result of conduct  
6 which is prohibited under Section 1(a) and who must bring civil action to  
7 remove any clouds from their title or interest in the real property, or to  
8 clear their title or interest in the real property shall be entitled to  
9 treble actual damages, punitive damages and costs, including all reasonable  
10 attorney fees and other costs of litigation reasonably incurred.

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12           *SECTION 3. The provisions of this act shall not apply to bona fide  
13 filings of lis pendens, materialmen's liens, laborer's liens, and other  
14 legitimate notice and protective filings as provided by law.*

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16           SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent  
17 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
18 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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20           SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
21 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
22 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
23 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
24 act are declared to be severable.

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26           SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
27 hereby repealed.
