## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 6-64-406(B) TO REVISE THE  
10 FORMULA FOR ALLOCATING ENROLLMENT POSITIONS OF THE  
11 FRESHMEN CLASS AT THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS FOR MEDICAL  
12 SCIENCES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

14 "REVISE FORMULA FOR ALLOCATING  
15 ENROLLMENT POSITIONS OF THE FRESHMEN  
16 CLASS AT THE U OF A MEDICAL SCIENCES."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20

21 *SECTION 1. Effective January 1, 1996, Arkansas Code 6-64-406(b) is*  
22 *amended to read as follows:*

23 "(b) The Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas shall allocate  
24 the first *eighty-two percent (82%)* of all enrollment positions for the  
25 freshman medical class among Arkansas congressional districts, using the  
26 population of each congressional district as determined by the last federal  
27 decennial census to determine that district's proportion of the freshman  
28 positions so allocated and shall assign those apportioned enrollment  
29 positions for each district to those applicants who are legal residents in  
30 that particular congressional district."

31

32 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent  
33 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
34 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

1           SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
2 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
3 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
4 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
5 act are declared to be severable.

7           SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
8 hereby repealed.
