For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND
10 ADMINISTRATION - DIVISION OF RACING FOR THE BIENNIAL
11 PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1997; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

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Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE
15 AND ADMINISTRATION - DIVISION OF RACING
16 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 1995-97 BIENNIUM."

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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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20 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
21 Department of Finance and Administration - Division of Racing for the 1995-97
22 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries
23 shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and
24 Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and
25 all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a
26 specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt
27 from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All
28 persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the
29 provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas
30 Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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5 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the

6 Department of Finance and Administration - Division of Racing for the 1995-97

7 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees,

8 to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such

9 purposes: forty-seven (47) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at

10 rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and

11 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate

12 classification.

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14 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the

15 Department of Finance and Administration - Division of Racing, to be payable

16 from the State Central Services Fund, for personal services and operating

17 expenses of the Department of Finance and Administration - Division of Racing

18 for the biennial period ending June 30, 1997, the following:

 7 the Department of Finance and Administration - Division of Racing - Horse
 8 Racing, for the 1995-97 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time

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 29 SECTION 5. EXTRA HELP - DOG RACING. There is hereby authorized, for
 30 the Department of Finance and Administration - Division of Racing - Dog
 31 Racing, for the 1995-97 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time
 32 or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds
 33 appropriated herein for such purposes, such employees shall be authorized to
 34 work over 1,000 hours per year:

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14 SECTION 6. The Director of the Department of Finance and
 15 Administration shall set a maximum number of racing passes to be printed and
 16 issued annually and it shall not be less than the number printed in 1990.

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18 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
 19 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
 20 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
 21 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
 22 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 23 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 24 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 25 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 26 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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28 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 29 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 30 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
 31 which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
 32 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
 33 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
 34 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
 35 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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SECTION 9. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 10. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 11. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 1:2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1995.

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
