7 For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 20-22-301 TO PROVIDE THAT
9 CERTAIN FORESTRY COMMISSION EMPLOYEES SHALL HAVE POLICE
10 POWERS TO ENFORCE THEFT OF TIMBER LAWS AND UNLAWFUL
11 DUMPING LAWS WHEN THE UNLAWFUL DUMPING OCCURS ON FOREST
12 LANDS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

14 Subtitle

15 "TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 20-22-301 TO
16 PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN FORESTRY COMMISSION
17 EMPLOYEES SHALL HAVE POLICE POWERS TO
18 ENFORCE THEFT OF TIMBER LAWS AND
19 UNLAWFUL DUMPING LAWS WHEN UNLAWFUL
20 DUMPING OCCURS ON FOREST LANDS."

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 20-22-301(a) is amended to read as follows:
25 "(a) The Arkansas Forestry Commission shall designate those employees
26 of the commission who shall have the powers of peace officers in the
27 enforcement of the fire laws, theft of property laws to the extent they apply
28 to theft of timber, and laws pertaining to the unlawful disposal of solid
29 waste when the unlawful disposal occurs on forest land."

30

31 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
32 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
33 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

34

35 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to

1 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
2 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
3 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
4 act are declared to be severable.

5

6 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
7 hereby repealed.
