7 For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 24-5-104 TO CHANGE THE
9 MEMBERSHIP OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE STATE HIGHWAY
10 EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM TO REFLECT THE CURRENT TITLE
11 FOR THE DEPUTY DIRECTOR/CHIEF ENGINEER; AND FOR OTHER
12 PURPOSES."

14 Subtitle

15 "TO UPDATE THE LIST OF MEMBERS OF THE
16 BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE STATE HIGHWAY
17 EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-5-104(b) is amended to read as follows:
22 "(b)(1) The board of trustees shall consist of six (6) members: The
23 Treasurer of State, the Director of the Department of Finance and
24 Administration, the Deputy Director/Chief Engineer of the Arkansas State
25 Highway and Transportation Department, a retiree from the Arkansas State
26 Highway and Transportation Department, and two (2) regularly qualified
27 members of the system.

28 (2) The board shall cause an election to be held by letter
29 ballot in June of each year, after thirty (30) days' written notice to the
30 membership, for the purpose of electing two (2) employee members and one (1)
31 retiree member who shall serve for two (2) years.

32 (3) In case of a vacancy of any employee member of the board,
33 the board shall fill the vacancy until the next regular election, when the
34 vacancy shall be filled by the election procedure specified in this
35 subsection."

2 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature
3 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
4 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

5

6 SECTION 3. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to
7 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect
8 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
9 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this
10 act are declared to be severable.

11

12 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
13 hereby repealed.
