18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
19	
20	SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
21	Arkansas State Highway & Transportation Department, for the biennial period
22	ending June 30, 1997, the following maximum number of regular employees and
23	the maximum annual salary for such employees; and no greater salary than that
24	established herein shall be paid to any employee from appropriations
25	hereinafter made for said Department. The annual salaries to be paid to each
26	employee authorized herein shall be determined by the Arkansas Highway
27	Commission within the limitations as set out in this Section and the funds
28	and the appropriations made available for such purposes. All positions
29	established herein shall be exempt from the provisions of the Uniform
30	Personnel Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et
31	seq.), or its successor, but shall not be exempt from the provisions of the
32	Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act. Provided further that the
33	salaries for the pay periods beginning June 22, 1995, and June 20, 1996, can
34	be paid from the salaries and overtime authorized for the fiscal years ending
35	June 30, 1996 and June 30, 1997 respectively.

8 SECTION 9. TRANSFERS AUTHORIZED. Any savings in the amount 9 appropriated in Section 2 for Item (1) Salaries, Item (2) Overtime, Item (3) 10 Personal Services Matching, or any sub-item of Item (4) Maintenance, 11 Operation, Construction, etc., may be transferred by the Director of the 12 State Highway and Transportation Department to any sub-item of Item (4), by 13 notifying the Director of Finance and Administration and the Auditor of State 14 to transfer said savings to a specific sub-item of Item (4) and make it 15 available for said purpose during the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 10. SOCIAL SECURITY AND RETIREMENT. The State Highway and Transportation Department's expenses for Social Security Matching and administrative costs thereof are to paid to the Social Security Matching Fund, in accordance with the regulations or instructions of the Department of Finance and Administration. The State Highway and Transportation Department's expenses for Highway Retirement Matching shall be paid to the State Highway Employees Retirement System, in accordance with the instructions of said system, as directed by the State Highway Commission.

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SECTION 11. PERSONAL SERVICES MATCHING TRANSFER. Provided that in the event amounts appropriated in Item (3) Section 2, Personal Services Matching, are insufficient in either year of the biennium to pay the amounts at the rates stipulated by law to be paid for each of these items, an additional amount as determined and requested by the Director of Highways and Transportation will be transferred by the Director of Finance and Administration and the Auditor of State from Item (4) Maintenance, Operation, Construction, Reconstruction, etc., to Item (3) in Section 2, to enable the State Highway and Transportation Department to pay the required matching

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1 funds.

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3 SECTION 12. LIABILITY INSURANCE PREMIUM REIMBURSEMENT. The Arkansas 4 Highway Commission is hereby authorized to reimburse from funds appropriated 5 in Item (4) of Section 2 of this Act, State Highway and Transportation 6 Department employees for personal liability insurance premiums paid by State 7 Highway and Transportation Department employees for liability coverage on 8 state owned vehicles of the Highway and Transportation Department up to a 9 maximum of Fifty Dollars (\$50) per annum per employee, at the option of the 10 eligible employee.

12 SECTION 13. UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS. The Arkansas State Highway and 13 Transportation Department is authorized to pay from Item (3) of Section 2 14 hereof, the Unemployment Premiums and Workers Compensation Premiums, at a 15 rate not in excess of the Agency's experience rate, under the provisions of 16 regulations established by the Department of Finance and Administration. 17

TRANSFER PROVISION. Provided, that any unexpended SECTION 14. 18 appropriation balance, remaining on June 30, 1996, in the appropriation 19 authorized in Section 2 hereof, for Item (1) Regular Salaries; Item (2) 20 21 Overtime Compensation; Item (3) Personal Services Matching; and Item (4) 22 Maintenance, Operations, Construction, and other items shall be transferred 23 by the Chief Fiscal Officer and the Auditor of State to Item (4) (A) Oper. 24 Expenses in Section 2 hereof, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1996 and 25 ending June 30, 1997, and made available for use in said year, and that any 26 unexpended appropriation balance made herein for Highway Special Construction, Federal Highway Trust, State Aid Roads and Highway Safety 27 28 Special remaining on June 30, 1996 shall be transferred forward by the Chief 29 Fiscal Officer and the Auditor of State to the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1996, and ending June 30, 1997, and made available for the same purposes. 30 31

32 SECTION 15. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS. The Arkansas Highway Commission 33 is hereby authorized to take appropriate action as necessary to restrict or 34 reduce the operating, administration, and other associated costs of the State 35 Highway and Transportation Department, including the Arkansas Highway Police

Division, for the biennial period ending June 30, 1997. Provided further,
that the Arkansas Highway Commission is directed to furnish the Arkansas
Legislative Council with an expenditure status report regarding the financial
activities of the State Highway and Transportation Department at least
quarterly, beginning no later than September 30, 1989.

7 SECTION 16. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 8 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 9 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 10 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 11 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 12 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 13 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 14 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 15 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

16

SECTION 17. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 18. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

30 SECTION 19. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the 31 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such 32 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which 33 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this 34 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

1 SECTION 20. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict 2 with this Act are hereby repealed.

3

SECTION 21. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1995.

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
