## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 5 CHAPTER 56 OF THE ARKANSAS CODE  
9 ANNOTATED TO DEFINE FOOD COUPONS TO INCLUDE MAGNETICALLY  
10 ENCODED DEVICES OR OTHER INSTRUMENTS OR PROCESS ISSUED IN  
11 CONFORMITY WITH THE FEDERAL FOOD STAMP LAW; AND FOR OTHER  
12 PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

15

"TO DEFINE FOOD COUPONS."

16

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 5-56-101 is amended by inserting an  
20 additional subsection at the end thereof to read as follows:

21 "(c) As used in this chapter the term food coupon means any printed  
22 material, magnetically encoded instrument or other device or process issued  
23 by the Department of Human Services, or its successors, the purpose of which  
24 is to permit the purchase of food as provided for by the Federal Food Stamp  
25 Act (7 U.S.C. 2011 et seq.) or regulations promulgated pursuant thereto."

27 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent  
28 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
29 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

30

31 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
32 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
33 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
34 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
35 act are declared to be severable.
