For An Act To Be Entitled

7 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 16-110-415 TO PROVIDE FOR
8 THE LIEN UPON THE GARNISHMENT OF SALARIES AND WAGES TO
9 CONTINUE UNTIL THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF THE JUDGMENT AND COSTS
10 ARE PAID OR SATISFIED; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

12 "TO PROVIDE FOR GARNISHMENTS ON WAGES
13 AND SALARIES TO CONTINUE UNTIL THE TOTAL
14 AMOUNT OF THE JUDGMENT IS PAID OR
15 SATISFIED."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 16-110-415 is amended to read as follows:
20
21 "16-110-415. Garnishment of wages.

22
23 (a) Upon the garnishment of salaries, wages, or other compensation due
24 from the employer garnishee, the employer garnishee shall hold, to the extent
25 of the amount due upon the judgment and costs, subject to the order of the
26 court, any nonexempt wages due or which subsequently become due. The
27 judgment or balance due thereon is a lien on salaries, wages, or other
28 compensation due at the time of the service of the execution, or as set out
29 in subsection (b).

30
31 (b) The lien provided for in subsection (a) of this section shall
32 continue as to subsequent earnings until the total amount due upon the
33 judgment and costs is paid or satisfied. The lien on subsequent earnings
34 shall terminate sooner if the employment relationship is terminated or if the
35 underlying judgment is vacated or modified."

1 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature
2 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
3 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

5 SECTION 3. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to
6 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect
7 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
8 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this
9 act are declared to be severable.

10

11 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
12 hereby repealed.
