HOUSE BILL 1169

For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO REQUIRE PERSONS WHO HAVE PLEADED GUILTY,
PLEADED NOLO CONTENDERE, OR BEEN FOUND GUILTY MORE THAN
ONCE OF CERTAIN VIOLENT FELONY OFFENSES TO SERVE THEIR
ENTIRE SENTENCE IN A CORRECTIONAL FACILITY WITHOUT
ELIGIBILITY OF PAROLE OR TRANSFER TO A COMMUNITY
PUNISHMENT FACILITY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

"TO REQUIRE PERSONS GUILTY MORE THAN
ONCE OF CERTAIN FELONY OFFENSES TO SERVE
THEIR ENTIRE SENTENCE"

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any law or regulation to the contrary, any person who pleads guilty, nolo contendere or is found guilty of any of the following felony offenses and has previously pleaded guilty, nolo contendere or been found guilty of any of the following felony offenses or its equivalent in another jurisdiction shall serve their entire sentence in a correctional facility operated by the Department of Correction without eligibility of parole or transfer to a community punishment facility;

- (A) Capital murder, § 5-10-101;
- (B) Murder in the first degree, § 5-10-102;
- (C) Murder in the second degree, § 5-10-103;
- (D) Kidnapping, § 5-11-102;
- (E) Aggravated robbery, § 5-12-103;
- (F) Battery in the first degree, § 5-13-201;
- (G) Terroristic act, § 5-13-310;

- 1 (H) Rape, § 5-14-103;
- 2 (I) Criminal use of prohibited weapons, § 5-73-104;
- 3 (J) Unlawful discharge of a firearm from a vehicle, § 5-74-107.

5 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
6 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
7 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

9 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
10 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
11 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
12 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
13 act are declared to be severable.

15 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
16 hereby repealed.
