17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated 16-17-108 is amended to read as							
20	follows:							
21	"16-17-108. Salaries of personnel and other requirements of various							
22	municipal courts.							
23	(a) The Arkadelphia-Clark County Municipal Court Judge shall receive							
24	an annual salary of not less than twenty-six thousand five hundred dollars							
25	(\$26,500) nor more than thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000), and the							
26	Arkadelphia-Clark County Municipal Court Clerk shall receive an annual salary							
27	of not less than twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) nor more than twenty-four							
28	thousand dollars (\$24,000), such salaries to be established annually by the							
29	Clark County Quorum Court. Upon approval by the Clark County Quorum Court,							
30	the Arkadelphia-Clark County Municipal Court Judge may appoint one (1) deputy							
31	municipal clerk to receive such salary as established by the Clark County							
32	Quorum Court.							
33	(b) The Ashdown Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary							
34	of not less than twenty-three thousand four hundred seventeen dollars							

35 (\$23,417) nor more than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000), as determined by

1 the governing body of the City of Ashdown and the Quorum Court of Little
2 River County. Such salary shall be paid sixty-two percent (62%) by Little
3 River County and thirty-eight percent (38%) by the City of Ashdown unless
4 otherwise agreed by the Quorum Court of Little River County and the governing
5 body of the City of Ashdown.

6 (c) The Ash Flat Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary 7 of not less than six thousand dollars (\$6,000) nor more than twenty-five 8 thousand dollars (\$25,000), and the Ash Flat Municipal Court Clerk shall 9 receive an annual salary of not less than four thousand eight hundred dollars 10 (\$4,800) nor more than fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000), as determined by 11 the Quorum Court of Sharp County, and to be paid by Sharp County.

12 (d) The Augusta Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary 13 of not less than nine thousand dollars (\$9,000) nor more than ten thousand 14 eight hundred dollars (\$10,800), the city and the county to share the cost 15 equally.

(e) The Batesville Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual
 salary of not less than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000) nor more than
 thirty-two thousand dollars (\$32,000), as determined by the governing body of
 Batesville and the Quorum Court of Independence County.

(f) The Beebe Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) nor more than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000). The municipal court clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than fourteen thousand dollars (\$14,000) nor more than twenty-two thousand dollars (\$22,000).

(g) The Benton Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) nor more than fifty-nine thousand dollars (\$59,000), and the court clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) nor more than thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000). Such salaries shall be as determined by the governing body of the City of Benton and the Saline County Quorum Court.

(h) The Benton County Municipal Court-West Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than seven thousand dollars (\$7,000) and not more than seventeen thousand dollars (\$17,000) as determined by the Benton County So Quorum Court and the governing bodies of the City of Gentry and the City of

Decatur. One-half (1/2) of such salary is to be paid by Benton County,
 one-fourth (1/4) of the salary is to be paid by the City of Decatur, and
 one-fourth (1/4) of the salary is to be paid by the City of Gentry.

4 (i) The Bentonville Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual 5 salary of not less than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) nor more than 6 thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000), as determined by the City Council of 7 Bentonville in concurrence with the Benton County Quorum Court. The court 8 clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than fifteen thousand 9 dollars (\$15,000) nor more than twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000), as 10 determined by the City Council of Bentonville in concurrence with the Benton 11 County Quorum Court. The deputy court clerks shall receive an annual salary 12 of not to exceed fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000), as determined by the 13 City Council of Bentonville in concurrence with the Benton County Quorum 14 Court.

(j) The Berryville Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual
salary of not less than sixteen thousand dollars (\$16,000) and not more than
twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000).

(k) The Biscoe Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of
 not less than three thousand nine hundred dollars (\$3,900) nor more than
 thirteen thousand nine hundred dollars (\$13,900).

(1) The Blytheville Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual
salary of not less than twenty-eight thousand dollars (\$28,000) nor more than
thirty-three thousand dollars (\$33,000), as may be approved by the
Mississippi County Quorum Court and the governing body of the City of
Blytheville.

The Booneville Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual 26 (m) salary of not less than twenty thousand five hundred dollars (\$20,500) nor 27 28 more than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000), as may be determined by the City 29 Council of the City of Booneville and the Quorum Court of Logan County, and shall be payable one-half (1/2) by the City of Booneville and one-half (1/2)30 by Logan County, and shall be paid in twelve (12) equal monthly installments. 31 The Brinkley Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary 32 (n) 33 of not less than ten thousand two hundred dollars (\$10,200) nor more than 34 twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000), and the Brinkley Municipal Court 35 Clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than ten thousand four

hundred eighty-eight dollars (\$10,488) and not more than twenty thousand
 dollars (\$20,000).

3 (o) The Bryant Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of 4 not less than twenty-eight thousand dollars (\$28,000) nor more than 5 thirty-seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$37,500).

6 (p) The Cabot Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of 7 not less than thirteen thousand dollars (\$13,000) nor more than twenty 8 thousand dollars (\$20,000), as may be determined by the governing body of the 9 City of Cabot.

10 (q) The Camden Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of 11 not less than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) nor more than forty-five 12 thousand dollars (\$45,000), to be paid by the City of Camden and Ouachita 13 County.

(r) The Carlisle Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary
of not less than four thousand five hundred dollars (\$4,500) nor more than
fourteen thousand five hundred dollars (\$14,500).

17 (s) The Judge of the Municipal Court of Charleston shall receive an 18 annual salary of not less than nine thousand dollars (\$9,000) per year nor 19 more than ten thousand eight hundred dollars (\$10,800).

(t) The Clarendon Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than four thousand eight hundred dollars (\$4,800), and the Clarendon Municipal Court Clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than eight thousand nine hundred eighty-eight dollars (\$8,988).

(u) The Clarksville Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) nor more than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000). Such salary shall be determined by the governing body of the City of Clarksville and the Johnson County Quorum Rourt, with the City of Clarksville paying forty percent (40%) of the amount and Johnson County paying sixty percent (60%) of the amount.

(v) The Clinton Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than seven thousand dollars (\$7,000) nor more than twenty-seven thousand dollars (\$27,000), and the municipal court clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than six thousand dollars (\$6,000) nor more than fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000), and the deputy clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than two thousand dollars (\$2,000) nor more than

1 four thousand five hundred dollars (\$4,500).

2 (w) The Conway Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of 3 not less than forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000) nor more than sixty-five 4 thousand dollars (\$65,000).

The Judge of the Municipal Courts of Corning, Piggott, and Rector 5 (x) 6 shall receive an annual salary of not less than seventeen thousand dollars 7 (\$17,000) nor more than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000), to be paid, 8 as well as other current benefits, in equal monthly installments by Clay 9 County; fifty percent (50%) of the amount shall be reimbursed by the City of Corning, the City of Piggott, and the City of Rector at eighteen and one-half 10 percent (18.5%), eighteen and one-half percent (18.5%), and thirteen percent 11 (13%), respectively, to the county treasury. The clerks of the respective 12 13 municipal courts shall receive an annual salary of not less than four 14 thousand five hundred dollars (\$4,500), and not to exceed six thousand dollars (\$6,000), to be paid, as well as other current benefits, in equal 15 monthly installments by Clay County; fifty percent (50%) of the amount shall 16 be reimbursed by the respective cities. 17

(y)(1) The Judge of the Municipal Court of Craighead County shall be a 18 full-time municipal judge and shall receive as compensation for services an 19 annual salary of not less than forty-five thousand three hundred dollars 20 21 (\$45,300) nor more than fifty-five thousand dollars (\$55,000) as determined 22 by the Quorum Court of Craighead County and the governing body of the City of 23 Jonesboro, to be paid in equal monthly installments. The amount of said 24 salary shall be appropriated by ordinance adopted by the Quorum Court of 25 Craighead County. The amount of said salary and necessary expenses 26 appropriated for said court shall be apportioned among, and paid to the county from, the respective cities of the first and second class, 27 28 incorporated towns, and the government of Craighead County as a prorated 29 amount based on the number of cases filed from each of such towns and cities 30 and the county during the preceding calendar year. Apportionment of the costs of said court shall be by order of the municipal court upon certification of 31 the cases filed by the Clerk of the Municipal Court of Craighead County. 32 (2) The Judge of the Municipal Court of Craighead County shall 33

34 maintain dockets and hold court, as deemed necessary, in each of the county 35 seats of Craighead County, and may establish dockets and hold court in such

other cities and towns in Craighead County as deemed necessary by ordinance

3 (z) The Crossett Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary 4 of not less than ten thousand eight hundred dollars (\$10,800) nor more than 5 twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000), and the municipal court clerk shall 6 receive an annual salary of not less than seven thousand dollars (\$7,000) nor 7 more than seventeen thousand dollars (\$17,000).

(aa) The DeWitt Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary 8 9 of not less than eight thousand one hundred four dollars (\$8,104) nor more 10 than eighteen thousand one hundred four dollars (\$18,104), and the municipal 11 court clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than seven thousand 12 five hundred eleven dollars and ninety-six cents (\$7,511.96) nor more than 13 seventeen thousand five hundred eleven dollars and ninety-six cents 14 (17,511.96), and the deputy clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less 15 than five thousand four hundred seventy-seven dollars (\$5,477) nor more than 16 fifteen thousand four hundred seventy-seven dollars (\$15,477). Such salaries shall be determined by the governing body of the City of DeWitt and the 17 Arkansas County Quorum Court and paid equally by the city and the county. 18 (bb) The DeQueen Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary 19 of not less than twenty-one thousand dollars (\$21,000) nor more than thirty 20 21 thousand dollars (\$30,000). The DeQueen Municipal Court Clerk shall have an 22 annual salary of not less than fourteen thousand dollars (\$14,000). The 23 salaries, expenses, and operating costs of the Municipal Court of the City of 24 DeQueen shall be paid equally by the City of DeQueen and the County of

(cc) The DeValls Bluff Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than three thousand six hundred dollars (\$3,600) nor more than thirteen thousand six hundred dollars (\$13,600).

Sevier.

(dd) The Des Arc Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary
of not less than seven thousand dollars (\$7,000) nor more than fifteen
thousand dollars (\$15,000).

(ee) The Dermott Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than sixteen thousand dollars (\$16,000) nor more than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000), and the court clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000) nor more than

eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000), provided, however, that the court
 clerk's position shall be a full-time or part-time position.

3 (ff) The Dumas Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of 4 not less than sixteen thousand dollars (\$16,000) nor more than twenty 5 thousand dollars (\$20,000). Such salary shall be paid one-half (1/2) by the 6 Desha County Quorum Court and one-half (1/2) by the City of Dumas and shall 7 be determined by the Desha County Quorum Court and the governing body of the 8 City of Dumas. The municipal court clerk shall be employed and paid by the 9 City of Dumas at such salary as the governing body shall determine.

10 (gg) The Elkins Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary 11 of not less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) nor more than twenty thousand 12 dollars (\$20,000). The annual salary for each clerk of the Elkins Municipal 13 Court shall be not less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) nor more than 14 thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000).

(hh) If a municipal court is established in Eudora, the judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than sixteen thousand dollars (\$16,000) nor more than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000), and the clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000) nor more than eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000).

(ii) The Eureka Springs Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual
salary of not less than sixteen thousand dollars (\$16,000) nor more than
twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000).

(jj) The Fayetteville Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) nor more than sixty-five thousand dollars (\$65,000). The annual salary of the Judge of the Municipal Court of Fayetteville may be increased in such amounts as may be agreed by the Quorum Court of Washington County and the governing body of the City of Fayetteville by ordinances or resolutions adopted by their respective bodies.

30 (kk) The Fordyce Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary 31 of not less than twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000) nor more than twenty-four 32 thousand dollars (\$24,000), and the clerks of said court shall receive an 33 annual salary of not less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) nor more than 34 twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000), as may be determined by the Fordyce City 35 Council and the Dallas County Quorum Court, and said salaries shall be paid

1 by the City of Fordyce and Dallas County in equal monthly installments.

2 (11) The Forrest City Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual 3 salary of not less than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000) nor more than 4 forty-eight thousand dollars (\$48,000) as may be set by the Quorum Court of 5 St. Francis County and the governing body of Forrest City.

6 (mm)(1) The qualified electors of the City of Fort Smith shall elect, 7 in addition to the presently elected municipal judge, an additional municipal 8 judge for the Second Division of the Fort Smith Municipal Court. The 9 qualified electors shall elect the judge at the general election for a 10 four-year term.

11 (2) The Fort Smith Municipal Court Judges shall receive annual 12 salaries of not less than fifty-six thousand dollars (\$56,000) nor more than 13 seventy-one thousand dollars (\$71,000) as may be determined by the governing 14 body of the City of Fort Smith.

15 (3) The municipal judges shall appoint a qualified elector to 16 serve as municipal court clerk. The salaries of the municipal judges and the municipal court clerks and any special judges authorized by this subdivision 17 18 and the operating expenses of the Fort Smith Municipal Court shall be paid 19 seventy percent (70%) by the City of Fort Smith and thirty percent (30%) by 20 Sebastian County. The municipal judges shall be of good moral character, 21 residents and electors of the city and the state, and shall possess the qualifications required by law for circuit and chancery judges. In the event 22 23 a municipal judge is ill, absent, or temporarily disqualified, that municipal judge shall designate a member of the bar regularly practicing in the court 24 to serve in his place during the illness, absence, or disqualification of the 25 municipal judge, and he shall have all the powers and authority of the 26 municipal judge. The special judge so appointed shall be paid one hundred 27 dollars (\$100) for each day he serves, to be paid by the city and county. 28

(4) Upon a vacancy in the office of municipal judge caused by
death or otherwise, the vacancy shall be filled as prescribed by the Arkansas
Constitution.

(nn) The Greenwood District Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000) nor more than thirty-four thousand dollars (\$34,000) to be set by the Quorum So Court of Sebastian County, and the salaries of the court clerk and the

1 clerk's deputies shall be set by the Quorum Court of Sebastian County. The 2 salaries shall be paid ninety percent (90%) by Sebastian County and ten 3 percent (10%) by the City of Greenwood. In order to defray the expenses of 4 operating the Greenwood District Municipal Court, ninety percent (90%) of the 5 Sebastian County net fines, ten percent (10%) of the City of Greenwood net 6 fines, and fifteen percent (15%) of all other cities' net fines processed by 7 the Greenwood District Municipal Court may/shall be deposited in a bank 8 account entitled the "Greenwood District Municipal Court Operating Fund" to 9 be administered by the Greenwood District Municipal Judge pursuant to a 10 budget approved as follows: The municipal judge shall submit a proposed 11 annual budget to a committee composed of the members of the quorum court that represent the Greenwood District of Sebastian County. If funds provided from the 16 fines as set out in this subsection above become insufficient, or excessive, the committee shall adjust the percentage of fines on a pro rata basis to 17 increase or decrease the funds necessary to operate the court pursuant to the 18 budget established in this subdivision. The Judge of the Greenwood District 19 Municipal Court shall be bonded in accordance with §§ 19-1-401 - 19-1-403. 20

(oo) The Hamburg Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than ten thousand eight hundred dollars (\$10,800) nor more than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000), and the municipal court clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than seven thousand dollars (\$7,000) nor more than seventeen thousand dollars (\$17,000).

(pp) The Judge of the Hampton Municipal Court shall receive an annual salary of not less than six thousand dollars (\$6,000) nor more than eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000), and the clerk of said court shall receive an annual salary of not less than six thousand dollars (\$6,000) nor more than eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000), as may be determined by the Hampton City Council and the Calhoun County Quorum Court, and such salaries shall be paid by the City of Hampton and Calhoun County in equal monthly installments.

33 (qq) The Harrisburg Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual 34 salary of not less than seven thousand two hundred dollars (\$7,200) nor more 35 than fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000).

1 (rr) The Harrison Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary 2 of not less than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) nor more than forty-five 3 thousand dollars (\$45,000).

4 (ss) The Hazen Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of 5 not less than six thousand four hundred dollars (\$6,400) nor more than 6 sixteen thousand four hundred dollars (\$16,400).

7 (tt) The Heber Springs Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual 8 salary of not less than fourteen thousand six hundred fifty-five dollars 9 (\$14,655) nor more than twenty-thousand dollars (\$20,000). Such salary shall 10 be set by and the payment thereof shall be apportioned between the county and 11 the city by agreement of the Cleburne County Quorum Court and the governing 12 body of the City of Heber Springs. The Heber Springs Municipal Court Judge 13 shall be elected by a county-wide vote of the qualified electors of Cleburne 14 County.

15 (uu) The Helena Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary 16 of not less than seventeen thousand four hundred dollars (\$17,400) nor more 17 than twenty-two thousand eight hundred dollars (\$22,800). Such salary shall 18 be determined by the governing body of Helena and the Phillips County Quorum 19 Court, with each responsible for paying one-half (1/2) of the salary.

(vv) The Hope Municipal Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) beginning January 1996 nor more than forty thousand dollars (\$40,000), and the clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than eighteen thousand six hundred dollars (\$18,600) nor more than twenty-six thousand dollars (\$26,000). The amount of such salaries shall be determined by agreement between the governing body of the City of Hope and the Quorum Court of Hempstead County.

(ww)(1) The Quorum Court of Garland County and the Board of Directors of the City of Hot Springs are hereby authorized by ordinances of the two (2) bodies to create an additional municipal court judgeship for the Hot Springs Municipal Court. If such additional judgeship is created, the current municipal judge shall preside over the First Division of the Hot Springs Municipal Court, and the person selected to the new judgeship shall preside over the Second Division of the Hot Springs Municipal Court.

34 (2) If an additional judgeship is created as authorized herein,
 35 the person to fill such position shall be elected at the next general

election after such authorization for a term of four (4) years, and all
 successors shall be elected for terms of four (4) years.

(3) Each Hot Springs Municipal Court Judge shall receive an
annual salary of not less than sixty-five thousand dollars (\$65,000) nor more
than seventy-six thousand dollars (\$76,000), and the Hot Springs Municipal
Court Clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty-six
thousand dollars (\$26,000) nor more than thirty-five thousand dollars
(\$35,000). The salaries shall be determined by the governing body of the
City of Hot Springs and the Quorum Court of Garland County.

10 (4) The salaries of the municipal judges and the municipal court 11 clerks and any special judges authorized by this subdivision, and the 12 operating expenses of the Hot Springs Municipal Court, shall be paid fifty 13 percent (50%) by the City of Hot Springs and fifty percent (50%) by Garland 14 County. In the event a municipal judge is ill, absent, or temporarily 15 disqualified, that municipal judge shall designate a member of the bar 16 regularly practicing in the court to serve in his place during such illness, 17 absence, or disqualification, and said designee shall have all the powers and 18 authority of the municipal judge.

19 (5) Upon a vacancy in the office of municipal judge caused by 20 death or otherwise, the governing body of the city and the quorum court of 21 the county shall appoint a person possessing the qualifications required for 22 municipal judge, who shall serve until the next general election, at which 23 election a municipal judge shall be elected in the manner prescribed by law 24 for the election of municipal judges to fill the unexpired term of the 25 municipal judge so vacating the office.

(6) Any municipal judge of the City of Hot Springs who has served or serves twelve (12) elective years as Municipal Judge of Hot Springs shall be eligible to retire and receive a retirement benefit equal to one-half (1/2) the salary the municipal judge was receiving at the time of retirement, for the remainder of his or her life. Provided, however, that only those years during which the judge did not engage in the private practice of law shall be eligible for this computation.

(7) In any municipality located in a county having a population
 of at least seventy thousand (70,000) but not more than seventy-five thousand
 (75,000) according to the 1990 Federal Decennial Census the governing body of

(B) The City Division shall hear all civil and criminal cases arising out of violations of city ordinances and those cases arising out of violations of state laws committed within the corporate limits of the City of Texarkana and all other cases in controversy arising within the corporate limits of the city within the jurisdiction of a municipal court as established by law. The City Division shall have a chief municipal court clerk whose salary shall be paid by the City of Texarkana in an amount to be determined by its governing body.

(C) The County Division shall hear all civil and criminal cases arising out of violations of any of the laws of the state committed outside the corporate limits of the City of Texarkana and all other cases in controversy arising outside the corporate limits of the city within the jurisdiction of a municipal court as established by law. The County Division
