HOUSE BILL

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF APPROPRIATIONS AS  
9 AUTHORIZED BY THE SECOND DIVISION OF CHANCERY COURT OF  
10 PULASKI COUNTY FOR THE ARKANSAS GAME AND FISH COMMISSION;  
11 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS GAME AND FISH  
15 COMMISSION REAPPROPRIATION."

16

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18

19 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the  
20 Arkansas Game and Fish Commission, to be payable from the segregated account  
21 within the Game Protection Fund, for the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission,  
22 the following:

23 (A) Effective June 23, 1995, the balance of the appropriation provided  
24 in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 10 of 1993, for capital improvements on Game  
25 and Fish Lands, in a sum not to exceed ..... \$70,625.

27 (B) Effective June 23, 1995, the balance of the appropriation provided  
28 in Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 10 of 1993, for capital improvements for  
29 Habitat Rehabilitation for quail and other wildlife, in a sum not to exceed .  
30 . . . . .  
31 \$11,282.

33 SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
34 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
35 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for

1 which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
2 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
3 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
4 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
5 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

6  
7       SECTION 3. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and  
8 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and  
9 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

10

11       SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
12 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
13 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
14 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
15 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

16

17       SECTION 5. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
18 with this Act are hereby repealed.

19

20       SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
21 Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
22 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period;  
23 that previous General Assemblies have provided appropriations for the  
24 projects provided enumerated in this act; that certain appropriations will  
25 expire before the adjournment of the General Assembly; and that if such  
26 appropriations expire, the projects and programs authorized herein will cease  
27 thereby depriving the citizens of the State of the benefits to be derived  
28 from such projects. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and  
29 this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,  
30 health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after June 23,  
31 1995.
