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## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO DESIGNATE THE DIRECTOR OF THE ARKANSAS STATE  
9 POLICE AS THE AGENT OF THE STATE TO ACT AS THE  
10 INTERMEDIARY BETWEEN THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT AND LOCAL  
11 GOVERNMENT FOR THE TRANSFER OF FEDERAL PROPERTY; AND FOR  
12 OTHER PURPOSES."

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### Subtitle

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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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22 SECTION 1. The Director of the Arkansas State Police is hereby  
23 designated as the Agent of the State of Arkansas for accepting federal  
24 property for the purpose of distributing the same to local governmental  
25 entities which have been designated by the federal government to receive  
26 property.

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28 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent  
29 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
30 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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32 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
33 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
34 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
35 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this

1 act are declared to be severable.

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3       SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
4 hereby repealed.

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6       SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the  
7 General Assembly that there is presently no law designating a state  
8 government official to act as an intermediary between the federal government  
9 and local governments for the purpose of transferring federal property to  
10 local governments; that this act so provides; and that this act should go  
11 into effect immediately in order to facilitate the transfer of federal  
12 property to local governments. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to  
13 exist and this act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the  
14 public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and  
15 after its passage and approval.

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
