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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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20 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - UTILITIES DIVISION. There is hereby
21 established for the Arkansas Public Service Commission - Utilities Division
22 for the 1995-97 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees
23 whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform
24 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or
25 its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any
26 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in
27 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
28 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
29 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
30 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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4 SECTION 16. CONTINGENCY RESTRICTION. In the event of unforeseen
5 conditions, additional appropriations become necessary that are not
6 authorized or contemplated in Section 3 of this Act and such events make it
7 necessary that the Public Service Commission - Utilities Division receives
8 additional appropriations to carry out the objectives of the agency, the
9 Director of the Public Service Commission is hereby authorized to request the
10 approval of the Governor and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, as
11 hereinafter provided, for transfer of the additional appropriations provided
12 in Section 13 to the appropriations provided the Utilities Division by
13 Section 3, but in no event shall the transfers exceed the appropriations
14 provided in Section 13 of this Act. Whenever the Director of the Public
15 Service Commission deems it necessary to establish additional appropriations
16 as authorized herein, he shall file with the Governor a written report
17 accompanied by necessary supporting documents setting forth the facts,
18 justifications, and circumstances that necessitate such appropriation. Upon
19 receipt of such reports and supporting documents, the Governor, or his
20 designee, shall study the same, and if he shall determine that such
21 additional appropriations are being sought in strict compliance with this
22 Act, the Governor, after seeking prior review by the Arkansas Legislative
23 Council or the Joint Budget Committee, may approve or modify such request for
24 additional appropriations as in his judgement he deems necessary, and shall
25 forward a copy thereof to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. Upon
26 receipt thereof, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall direct the State
27 Auditor to process said transfer upon his books in accordance with the
28 provisions as set out therein.

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3 (b) A monthly report shall be made to the Arkansas Legislative Council
4 describing all personnel transactions involving applications of any of the
5 provisions of this Section.

6 (c) This provision shall be in full force and effect for the biennium
7 beginning July 1, 1995, and ending June 30, 1997.

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9 SECTION 18. CARRY FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of the
10 appropriation authorized in Item (08) of Section 3 of this Act which remains
11 at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, shall be carried
12 forward and made available for the same purpose for the fiscal year ending
13 June 30, 1997.

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15 SECTION 19. Any unexpended balance of the appropriation authorized for
16 Renovation & Repairs to Building in Item (09) of Section 3 of this Act which
17 remains at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, shall be
18 carried forward and made available for the same purpose for the fiscal year
19 ending June 30, 1997.

20

21 SECTION 20. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
22 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
23 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
24 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
25 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
26 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
27 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
28 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
29 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

30

31 SECTION 21. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
32 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
33 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
34 which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
35 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

1 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
2 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
3 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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5 SECTION 22. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
6 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and
7 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

8

9 SECTION 23. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
10 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
11 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
12 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
13 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

14

15 SECTION 24. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
16 with this Act are hereby repealed.

17

18 SECTION 25. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by
19 the Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of
20 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year
21 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to
22 the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are
23 provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the
24 delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work
25 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential
26 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist
27 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
28 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after
29 July 1, 1995.

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
