HOUSE BILL 1252

For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARK. CODE ANN. §27-16-807 TO PROVIDE THAT ANY PERSON WITH A VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE ISSUED BY ANOTHER STATE MAY OBTAIN AN ARKANSAS DRIVER'S LICENSE BY SURRENDERING THAT LICENSE AND PAYING AN ADDITIONAL TRANSFER FEE OF FIVE DOLLARS (\$5.00); TO PROVIDE FOR DISPOSITION OF THESE FEES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT ANY PERSON WITH A VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE ISSUED BY ANOTHER STATE MAY OBTAIN AN ARKANSAS DRIVER'S LICENSE BY SURRENDERING THAT LICENSE AND PAYING A TRANSFER FEE OF FIVE DOLLARS (\$5.00)."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Ark. Code Ann. § 27-16-807 is amended to read as follows:

"27-16-807. Issuance to nonresident and military licensees.

(a) Any person sixteen (16) years of age or older who shall present to the office, or an authorized agent thereof, a valid driver's license issued to the person by another state or by a branch of the armed services of the United States, which is currently valid or which expired not more than thirty-one (31) days prior to the date presented, shall be issued an Arkansas driver's license if he surrenders the license to the office, *pays the license fee prescribed in § 27-16-801(a), pays the other fees required by § 27-16-801(e)*, pays a transfer fee of five dollars (\$5.00) and is tested and passes

1 the minimum requirements of the eyesight test prescribed in this chapter.

2 (b) The five dollar (\$5.00) transfer fee is paid in lieu of the fees
3 prescribed by Ark. Code Ann. § 27-16-801 (a)(1)(C) but shall be collected and
4 deposited in the same manner as prescribed by Ark. Code Ann. § 27-16-801(d)."

6 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
7 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
8 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

10 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
11 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
12 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
13 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
14 act are declared to be severable.

16 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
17 hereby repealed.
