# A Bill

HOUSE BILL 1269

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARK. CODE § 17-22-404 TO PROVIDE THAT THE  
9 CONTRACTOR'S LICENSING SURETY BOND DOES NOT APPLY TO  
10 INCOME TAXES AND THAT THE BOND SHALL COVER APPLICABLE  
11 TAXES OR ASSESSMENTS WHICH ARISE OUT OF WORK PERFORMED  
12 DURING THE TIME PERIOD COVERED BY THE BOND; AND FOR OTHER  
13 PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

16 "TO PROVIDE THAT THE CONTRACTOR'S  
17 LICENSING SURETY BOND SHALL NOT APPLY TO  
18 INCOME TAXES AND THAT THE BOND SHALL  
19 COVER APPLICABLE TAXES OR ASSESSMENTS  
20 WHICH ARISE OUT OF WORK PERFORMED DURING  
21 THE TIME PERIOD COVERED BY THE BOND."

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. Ark. code § 17-22-404(b)(3) is amended to read as follows:

26 "(3) Conditioned on the contractor complying with the tax laws of the  
27 state of Arkansas, other than income taxes, and when applicable, any city,  
28 county, school district, state agency, or other political subdivision of the  
29 state, the Arkansas Employment Security Act, § 11-10-101, et seq., the  
30 Workers' Compensation law, § 11-10-101, et seq., and the provisions of this  
31 subchapter and the bond shall cover such taxes or assessments, other than  
32 income taxes, which arise out of work performed by the contractor during the  
33 time period covered by the bond."

35 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent

1 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
2 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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4 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
5 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
6 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
7 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
8 act are declared to be severable.

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10 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
11 hereby repealed.

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13 SECTION 5. *EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the*  
14 *General Assembly that the present law that requires surety bonds be*  
15 *conditioned upon the tax laws of Arkansas are restricting the availability of*  
16 *surety bonds due to the requirement that they be conditioned upon compliance*  
17 *with the income tax laws of this state; that surety bonds should be as*  
18 *readily available as possible in order to comply with the various*  
19 *requirements of Arkansas law; that this act will result in surety bonds*  
20 *becoming more widely available; and that this act should therefore go into*  
21 *effect immediately. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and*  
22 *this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public*  
23 *peace, health, and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after*  
24 *its passage and approval.*
