8 "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE A FULL-TIME DEPUTY SHERIFF TO
9 PURCHASE CREDITED SERVICE IN THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES
10 RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR SERVICE AS AN AUXILIARY DEPUTY
11 SHERIFF; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23

24 SECTION 1. (a) A member of the public employees retirement system who
25 is or was a full-time deputy sheriff with at least five (5) years of service
26 as a full-time deputy sheriff shall be entitled to purchase credited service
27 in the system for service rendered as an auxiliary deputy sheriff. The
28 amount of service to be purchased shall not be less than one (1) month nor
29 more than five (5) years. Only service as an auxiliary deputy sheriff
30 rendered on or after March 24, 1983, the effective date of Act 757 of 1983,
31 shall qualify.

(b) To purchase the credited service the member must contribute an amount equal to the employer's matching contribution with six percent (6%) interest thereon. Since auxiliary deputy sheriffs receive no base salary, the basis for the purchase shall be based on the member_s entry salary as a

3 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
4 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
5 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

7 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
8 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
9 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
10 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
11 act are declared to be severable.

12

13 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
14 hereby repealed.
