19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Ark. Code Ann. § 16-17-501 is amended to read as follows:

"16-17-501. Generally.

23

24 Any city with a population of less than three thousand (3,000) persons,
25 according to any federal census, which had a municipal court in existence on
26 March 4, 1985, may create a municipal court under this subchapter."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly that the City of Augusta is in need of a municipal court and a municipal judge; that the population of Augusta is just above the limit set by current law; and that this act will allow Augusta to create a municipal court immediately. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
